We Hear and Read God's Word

First reading: 1Samuel 3:1-10

3 Now the boy Samuel was ministering to the LORD in the presence of Eli. And the word of the LORD was rare in those days; there was no frequent vision.

2 At that time Eli, whose eyesight had begun to grow dim so that he could not see, was lying down in his own place. **3** The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was.

4 Then the LORD called Samuel, and he said, "Here I am!" **5** and ran to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." But he said, "I did not call; lie down again." So he went and lay down.

6 And the LORD called again, "Samuel!" and Samuel arose and went to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." But he said, "I did not call,

my son; lie down again." **7** Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, and the word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him.

8 And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." Then Eli perceived that the LORD was calling the boy. **9** Therefore Eli said to Samuel, "Go, lie down, and if he calls you, you shall say, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant hears.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

10 And the LORD came and stood, calling as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant hears."

This Reading is from the Book of Psalms, the 139th Psalm vs 1-6, 13-18 (To be read responsively)

R: ¹ O LORD, you have searched me and known me!

C: ² **You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar.**

R: ³ You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways.

C: ⁴ **Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O LORD, you know it altogether.**

R: ⁵ You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me.

C: ⁶ **Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it.**

R: ¹³ For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb.

C: ¹⁴ **I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made.**

Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.

R: ¹⁵ My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret,
intricately woven in the depths of the earth.

C: ¹⁶ **Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them,
the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them.**

R: ¹⁷ How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

C: ¹⁸ **If I would count them, they are more than the sand. I awake, and I am still with you.**

⁴³ The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, "Follow me." ⁴⁴ Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. ⁴⁵ Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." ⁴⁶ Nathanael said to him, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see." ⁴⁷ Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is

no deceit!" ⁴⁸ Nathanael said to him, "How do you know me?" Jesus answered him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you." ⁴⁹ Nathanael answered him, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!" ⁵⁰ Jesus answered him, "Because I said to you, 'I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe?
