Confession and Forgiveness (Psalm 51)

- P: We come to this moment of confession in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. C: Amen!
- <u>P:</u> Have mercy on us, O God, according to Your loving-kindness; in Your great compassion blot out our offenses. <u>C:</u> Wash us from our wickedness and cleanse us from our sins.
- <u>P:</u> You, O God, know our sin. Nothing is hidden from You. Therefore, You are justified when You speak, and You are right when You judge.
- <u>C:</u> Make us pure, O God. Wash our slate clean. Turn from our sin and remember it no more.

We confess that sin has come between You and us. O God, We come before You now in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior to ask for Your forgiveness and a cleansing of our hearts. Hear our prayer. We want to be in a right relationship with You. Please remove all those things that we allow to get in the way. We are sorry for what we have done. We humbly come before You with our confessions and thanksgiving. Amen
- <u>P:</u> People of God, you have made confession of your sins before the Lord. Therefore, you are promised forgiveness through faith in Jesus Christ. So, by the authority of God our Father and Jesus Christ His only Son and by the power of the Holy Spirit, I boldly and confidently announce the forgiveness of all your sins. You have been washed clean and purified of your sins. Rejoice and be glad, for you are a child of God.
