## Important Information for the Buyer of a Springmill Lakes at Tamarack Unit

- Look under the Resources and Documents tab to see the Co-Owner's Handbook. This lists rules and regulations plus other items of interest to co-owners.
- Any/all changes (renovations/bushes and trees) inside or outside to the unit need prior approval
  by the COA Board via the Architectural Control form which can be found on the website. These
  changes must be approved by the Board prior to starting any renovation. This is to ensure the
  structural integrity of the unit is not compromised during renovation, such as when any walls are
  to be taken down or modified or heavier renovations such as kitchen islands or bathtubs being
  placed on the floor which could affect floor joists.
- Be sure to switch the ADT connection as soon as possible after closing. A connection to ADT
  must always be maintained. If you do not have a land line, ADT will provide a cell connector at
  the owner's expense. To maintain fire protection for everybody, the unit must always be
  connected to ADT. At sales closing, the new owner should assume the ADT account switching
  over the same as the other utilities.
