APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Roger Branscome moved to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from 9-May-2023. Bruce Butler seconded. All in favor. Motion approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

CLERK'S REPORT:

Amber Burgess made the clerk's report along with payables. The clerk informed the board that there were no expenses out of the ordinary, half of the 3rd Quarter O&M invoices were completed, and that the Guard Dog site for Beyond Hope was not working from March 16th to May 30th of 2023. The Total Expenses amount to be paid was \$8,477.56. Ellen Westfall moved to approve payment of the bills. Roger Branscome seconded. All in favor. Motion approved.

MAINTENANCE REPORT:

Operator Dex Vogel explained that the drilling for monitoring wells have been rescheduled for August 14, 2023. R.C. Worst has not notified Dex of when the three new electrical panels for the lift stations will arrive and that once it is scheduled it will be 3 weeks to a month to wait for installation of the panels which will be replaced one at a time. Presently, there is a seal leak on one pump and a bearing need replacing on the other motor. The cleanup of the road has started, and everything will be chipped then burned. Dex will be setting up the seepage testing equipment again to see what happened with the data from last Fall and see if the equipment is ok. If there is something wrong

with the equipment, the probes will have to be sent back to see if they are the problem because DEQ will not accept the present data.
