Root Beer Floats, sound good?

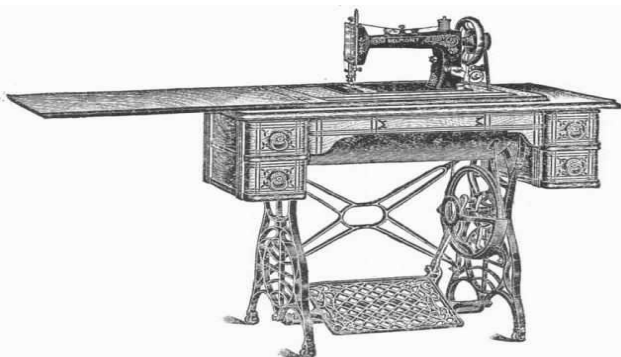
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

SCCQG QUARTERLY MEETING

We purchase group insurance each year from the Council. It covers, visitors, facilities where we hold our meetings and special events. It doesn't cover members as a whole. The cost is \$3.25 per member. This is much cheaper than insurance shopping for similar coverage. The annual coverage goes from September 29th to September 28th of the following year.

Meeting Program

Creative ideas and tried and true methods were part of the program presentation on workshops. Suggestions ranged from having the teacher work for you; you are hiring them, to awarding a gift certificate to a workshop. When shopping for a workshop it's important to keep in mind skill levels and availability of supplies. Some guilds have members sign up in January and non-refundable fees. Hosting a techniques night or workshop with multiple methods of doing a square is another idea.

Workshop fees discounted for registering up to two months in advance and registering and paying online can help to fill workshops as well.

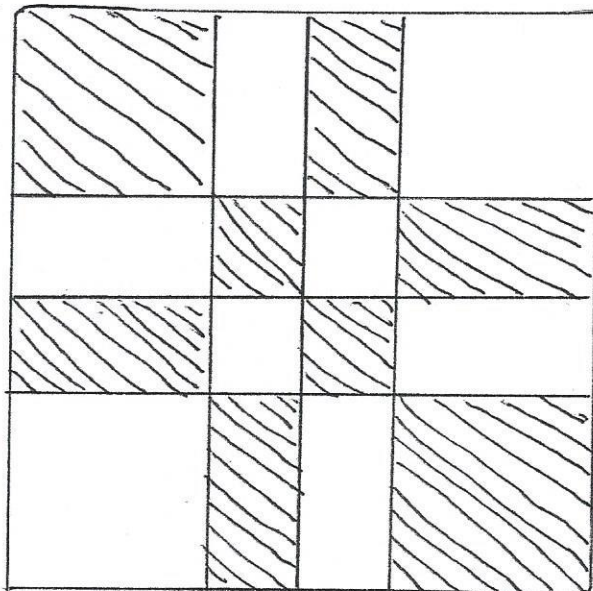
