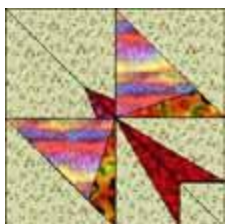

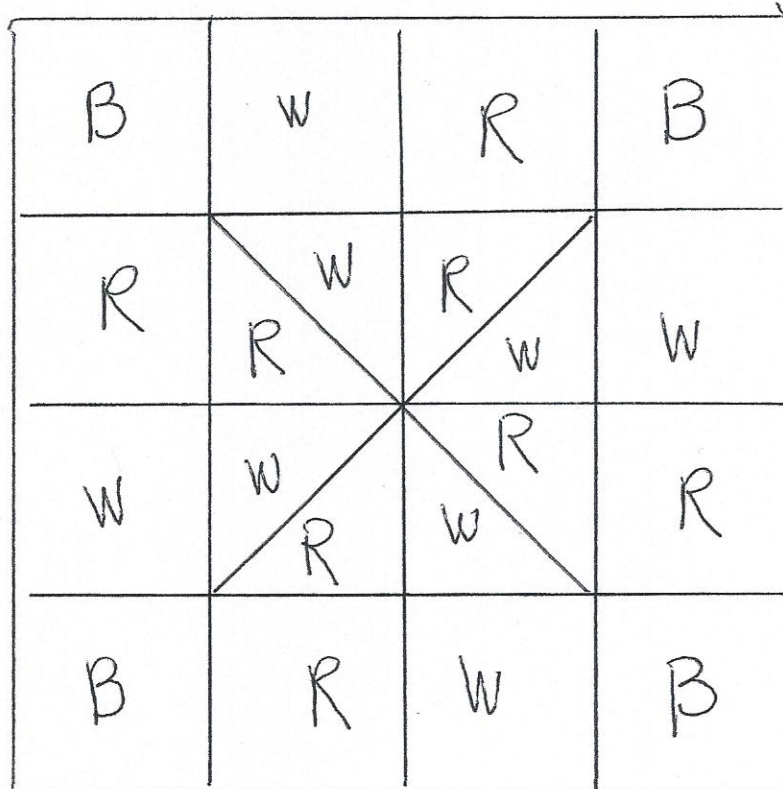
Technique-Pieced
