# July and August 2013

## Snail's Trail

Technique-Pierced

Block Size- 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"


Fabrics- White on white and red

- Cutting- White on white 1 67/8" sq. cut on the diagonal
  - 1 3 7/8" sq. cut on the diagonal
  - 1 7 3/16" sq. cut
  - 25/8" squares 2

Red

- 6 7/8" sq. cut on the diagonal 1
- 3 7/8" sq. cut on the diagonal 1
- 7 3/16" sq. cut M 1
- 2 5/8" squares 2

Total pieces- 16
