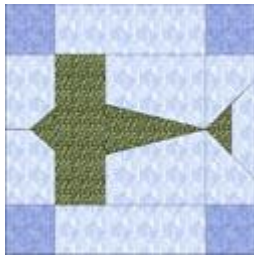

HOSPITALITY NEWS

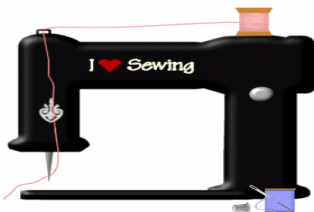

Just some of the information that has come from the survey:

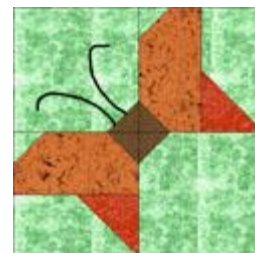
Opinions were evenly split between those who use the website and those who don't. Of those who don't, some might be interested in using the website now that they know that we have one or if it was made easier to use.

Quick Fun

Technique – Pieced

Block Size – 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"

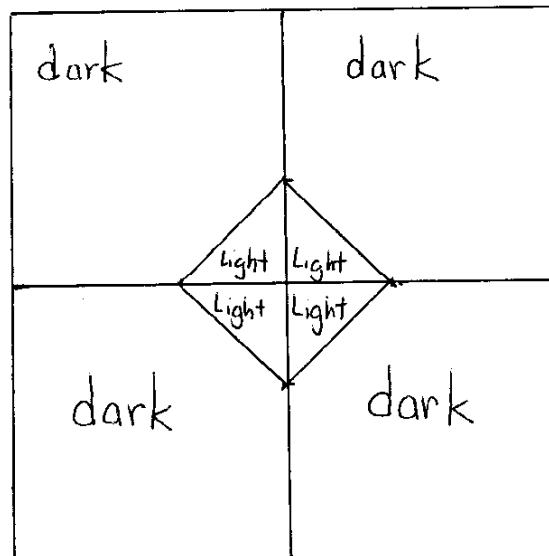
Fabrics- 4 different dark blues or browns and 4 different
Light tans, blue or browns

Cutting- darks cut 6 1/2" squares of each

Lights cut 3 1/2" squares of each

Sewing- snowball the light squares to the dark squares

Total pieces-8
