

Technique-Pieced

Block Size-12 ½" x 12 ½"

Fabrics- brown and white on white

Cutting- brown


1 8 ½" square

2 4 7/8" squares cut on the diagonal

White 1 4 ½" square

2 4 7/8" squares cut on the diagonal

Total pieces- 10
