The public is invited to come in and learn about their local quilt guild.

Raffle tickets for our beautiful Opportunity Quilt will be sold and, as we have the whole room, we can spread out for sewing. There is ample electricity for our machines and task lights and, a kitchen nearby we can use for food. I think it would be nice to have our own pot-luck that day and will be looking for ideas from you on how to do this. Friday, August 14 we can have access to the room to set-up the frames, tables, etc. then Saturday morning we arrive to hang our quilts. Each quilter will be responsible for bringing her/his quilts and spending time at the event sewing, chatting with the public, and ultimately taking down her/his quilts when it is time to go home. Of course we will all pitch in to take down the frames, tables, etc.

Please find a way to participate in this by volunteering to exhibit one or more of your quilts, help set-up and take down the frames and tables, organize our pot-luck lunch, and spend time informing the public that comes through about quilts and quilting. It's our day to shine!

Technique-Pieced


Size- 12 ¹/₂' x 12 ¹/₂'

Fabrics- 4 fabrics-white on white, white or beige fabric with a pattern, 2 different darks

Cutting- white on white $2 3 \frac{1}{2}$ x $6 \frac{1}{2}$

	4	$3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
	2	3 7/8" squares ℕ
Beige	2	3 7/8" squares ⊠
Dark 1	2	3.7/8" squares ⊠
Dark 2	- 2	3 7/8" squares 🗋
