Technique-Pieced

Size- 12 ½ " x 12 ½"

Fabric - white on white and a fall leaf colored fabric(I'm thinking brown, rust or dark orange)

Cutting – white on white 4 3 ½" squares

4 3 7/8" squares which are cut on the diagonal


Fall fabric

3 ½" squares

Number of pieces- 24
