

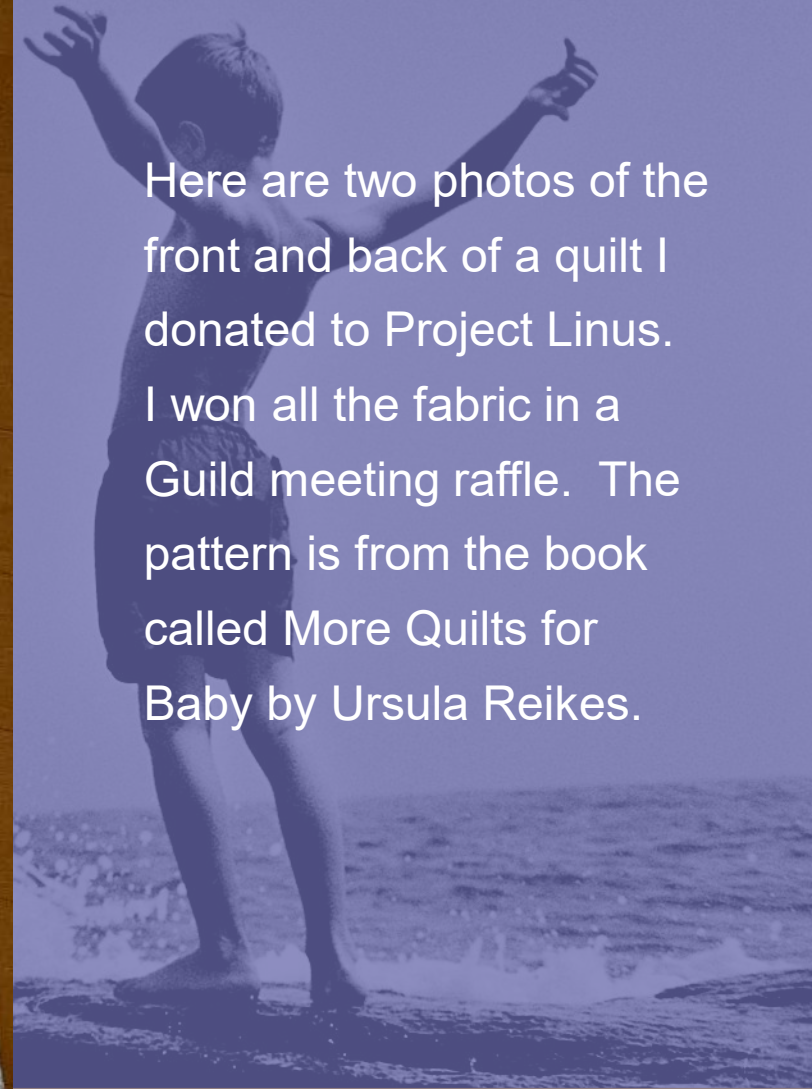

Whimsical Winter - this was a kit from Shabby Fabrics, It's all applique, and the shapes came pre-cut and with the adhesive already on, so I just had to position and iron down. I then quilted inside each piece to sew them down. The border is prairie points.



MELISSA NILSEN

Twinking Stars, pattern by Open Gate. I made this top 2 years ago, but couldn't decide how I wanted to quilt it. Since it's queen-sized, it was going to be a pain to do on my domestic machine. Last fall, Carol, Jean, and I took a road trip up to visit Donna, and I brought it to her and hired her to quilt it for me on her long-arm. When it came back to me, it sat here for a while longer before I got around to binding it, as I was in the midst of making all those quilts for my friends at the end of last year. But now it's done and on the guest bed. Finally!! yay!

Vinnie's Stars - this is a simple 2 block pattern of Sawtooth Stars and 4 patches. This is for the bed in our van. I finished the top last March, but then it waited a year for me to get around to quilting it. With our van trip looming, I had to stop procrastinating, and finally quilted it last month. We put it on the bed in the van earlier this week, and immediately saw that my measurements were wrong - there was only a couple inches of drop on the sides. So, I cut off the binding on the sides, added another 5 inches of border on each side, quilted it, and added binding to the new border. I appliqued a sashing strip over the seam to hide it. It's not a mistake, it's a feature 😊



MELISSA NILSEN

This pattern is called "Dripping With Diamonds" by Joanna Wilczynska, from the book *Jelly Roll Dreams*. My daughter asked me to make a quilt for her friend, and I wanted something that would come together quickly, so I thought a jellyroll quilt would do the trick. This was a lot more involved than I was expecting, but managed to get it done in time to take with us on our trip across country to see her. I used a Kaffe Fassett jellyroll and a little bit of yardage.

Begun at a workshop at Joyce's home. This is one of the Library of Congress pictures that our teacher made into a pattern. Joyce Wilkinson quilted it for me which has given it life beyond the stitching. I have bound it and put a sleeve for hanging in the same border fabric. Yes – it has a label!

I showed you the quilt I made for Opal (a great niece) with some of the tulip blocks. These are from a Sterns and Foster/Mountain Mist pattern. The blocks were hand sewn by Helen Christman. This is the original setting, but I have added a border to mine including an ice cream border. I have made a white scalloped edge which will go on with its label and be hand delivered to Sara. I just got it back from the Sue Handley (the quilter) yesterday.

complete...love it!

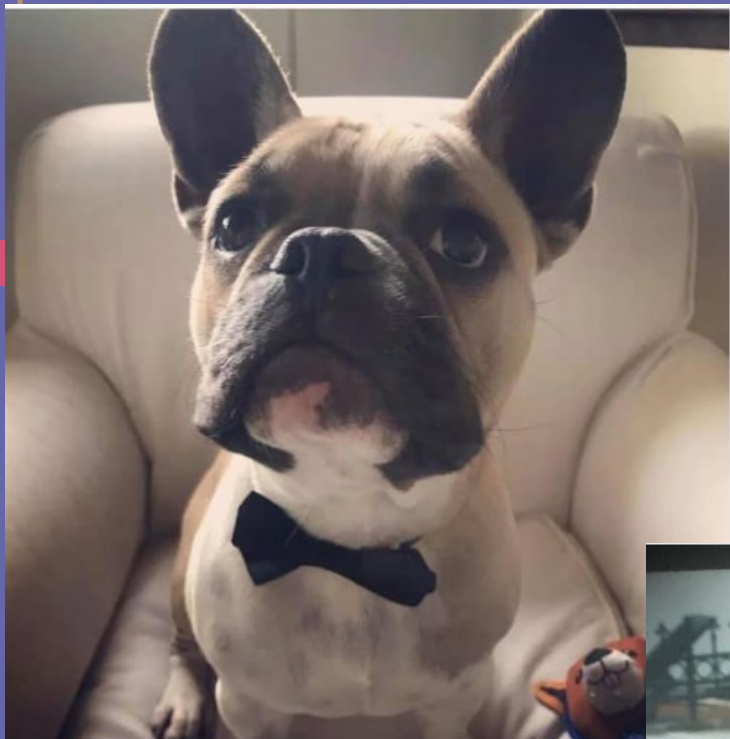


GUIDE DOGS OF AMERICA
