

Brynwood Swim Club

Policies

The Brynwood Swim Club is operated by a Board of Directors, voted on by club members, who carry out the administrative functions of the club.

As a condition of membership, each member agrees that the Brynwood Swim Club is absolved of all liability in a cause of action where it can be shown that there has been a failure to comply with regulations stated herein. Each member shall also acknowledge that he or she has read, and agrees to comply with all of the regulations of the Brynwood Swim Club.

The attendants on-duty are authorized by the Brynwood Board of Directors to evict anyone violating or failing to comply with club regulations. The attendants are also authorized to enforce additional rules or regulations as may be necessary for the club to maintain the highest standard of operation. Repeated infractions will be referred to the Board of Directors, who at their discretion, may suspend the club privileges of the violator and/or his entire family. The club and surrounding areas are monitored 24 hours a day by video surveillance.

The attendants shall be obeyed by all those using the club. They shall act as representatives of management and shall have the authority to enforce these regulations and to supervise the general conduct of swimmers. Emergencies should be reported to the attendant on duty. Non-emergencies, comments and complaints should be submitted to the Board of Directors via email at brynwoodmembership@gmail.com. A member of the board will respond within a week.

The club does not always have a lifeguard on duty, because of this a Swim at Your Own Risk policy is instituted.

General Rules

- 1. Members must check in at the front desk to gain entry to the pool area. All family members entering the pool must be checked in.
- 2. Brynwood Swim Club accepts no responsibility for money, valuables, or other articles belonging to those using the pool (loss or damage to personal property).
- 3. NO PETS are allowed in the pool enclosure.
- 4. Food and beverages may be brought to the pool. Members are responsible for properly disposing of their own refuse in the pool trashcans. NO GLASS containers of any kind will be permitted inside the pool area.
- 5. Tampering with or defacing club property or equipment is prohibited. Property damage costs will be charged to the responsible member.
- 6. No Smoking is allowed inside the pool fence.
- 7. Coolers are not permitted on the pool deck, next to the pool.
- 8. Stacking cans on the pool deck is not permitted.
- 9. Parents, whether present or not, are responsible for the conduct of their children using club facilities. Parents are required to ensure that their children are familiar with and abide by these regulations.
- 10. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by their parent or a designated chaperone (16 or over) appointed by their parents at all times. A minor may not be responsible for another minor. The parent or chaperone, not the attendant, shall be responsible for the safety and conduct of the child.
- 11. Babies wearing disposable or cloth diapers are not allowed in the pool. Special swim diapers are permitted.

Guests



- 1. All guests must be accompanied by and signed-in by a member upon entry. Guest log is located at the sign-in desk. **A guest is a non-member who lives within 50 miles of the Brynwood Pool Swim Club.
- 2. All guests will be charged a fee of \$5.00 per person, per day (max 5 days/season). If attendant is not present at the front desk, you must locate one prior to entry to pay the guest fee.
- 3. All guests are subject to all rules that apply to members.
- 4. Conduct of guests is the direct responsibility of the members who sponsor them.
- 5. Members are permitted to bring out-of-town guests free of charge. Out-of-Town is defined as coming from outside a 50-mile radius from Brynwood Swim Club. The Out-of-Town Guest Form must be filled out and provided to the attendant.

Health and Safety

- 1. Only persons in proper swimming attire will be permitted in the pool.
- 2. All commonly recognized rules of sanitation and safety shall be observed.
- 3. No running, pushing, hitting, wrestling, or horseplay will be permitted in or around the pool.
- 4. No diving in depths of less than five feet is permitted.
- 5. Babies wearing disposable or cloth diapers are not allowed the pool. Special swim diapers are permitted.
- 6. Members will be expected not to use the pool when they are ill, have an infection of any type, or have an open wound.
- 7. The attendant on duty will have sole discretion to close the pool during inclement weather, primarily during thunderstorms or in the presence of lightning.

Restrooms

- 1. Members are requested to help keep restroom facilities clean. Do not flush any foreign articles such as sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, or paper towels down the toilets.
- 2. Faulty plumbing is to be reported, upon its discovery, to a pool attendant.
- 3. All trash is to be disposed of in a trash container.

Pool Parties

- 1. Brynwood pool members may schedule private pool parties.
- 2. The pool may be used for a pool party any day during the entire pool season, except during scheduled events; e.g. home swim meets, neighborhood social events, etc.
- 3. The pool remains open for members during all pool parties scheduled during normal operating hours.
- 4. The party host will complete the rental agreement and pay fees at the time rental is booked.
- 5. All pool rules and regulations apply to all parties. The party host should ensure that all party guests adhere to pool policies and procedures.

Designated Guardians/Babysitters

- 1. All designated guardians/babysitters must be 16 years or older.
- 2. The designated guardian/babysitter is not required to be a pool member; however he/she must be indicated as such on the guest sign-in sheet or on the membership renewal form.
- 3. The non-member designated guardian/babysitter cannot visit the pool while "off-duty" or bring guests or his/her own family members.
- 4. All children under the care of a designated guardian/babysitter must be pool members.
- 5. Designated guardians/babysitters must follow the same pool rules as pool members.
