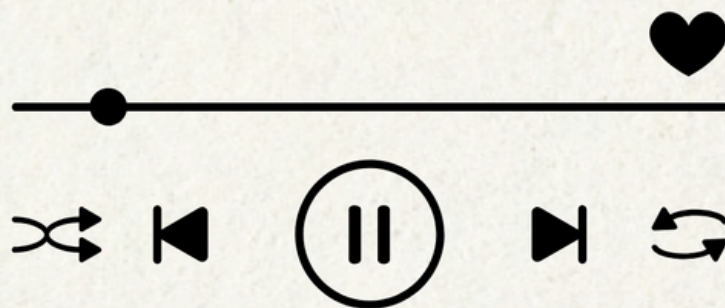
Senior Spotlight
