WHEREAS, the City of Bevil Oaks City Council approved to pay off the balance of debt owed to the City of Beaumont. The amount that had been budgeted to pay Beaumont for delinquent sewer payments is sufficient to pay the water meter payment without passing the cost on to water system Users.

WHEREAS, replacement of the budget line item "Due to Beaumont" to Water Meter Payment budget item will lower the monthly User Fee by \$5.00.

WHEREAS, slightly lowering the annual reserve requirement will result in an additional \$3.90 reduction in the User Fee.

WHEREAS, the total proposed User Fee reduction of \$8.90 per month will serve the best interests of the Citizens of Bevil Oaks.

BE IT RESOLVED, the City shall substitute its water meter payment in its budget to account for the elimination of the Beaumont delinquent sewer payment the City Council. Further, the City shall lower its annual reserve

requirement to result in a \$3.90 reduction in the User Fee. Further, the adjusted total user fee of \$31.00 per month will begin with the August 1, 2020 utility billing.
