

BACKGROUND CHECK GUIDELINES

To comply with the Texas Family Code, The Adam Walsh Act, and the policies of April Lopez and Associates

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS

An FBI criminal background check is required on all household individuals over age 14 if:

- Your adoption is being consummated in Travis County, Texas AND/OR
- Your adoption involves an out-of-state agency, attorney, or child AND/OR
- You are completing an international adoption AND/OR
- You have not lived in the state of the Texas for the previous consecutive five years

A Texas State DPS criminal background check is sufficient only if:

- You have lived in the state of Texas, consecutively, for more than the previous five years AND
- You adoption does not involve the ICPC process if there are no other states involved with this adoption AND
- Your adoption is NOT being consummated in Travis County, TX.

CENTRAL REGISTRY CHECKS (CPS)

A Central Registry Check (CPS) is required on all household members over age 14.

 Please fill out the "Central Registry Request" form 2970 that can be downloaded from TDFPS. For instruction on how to download this form, please see document entitled "Central Registry (CRC)Request Instructions".

Submit copies of all results to April Lopez and Associates upon receipt. Keep the originals for the home visit.

If anyone over the age of 14 in your home has resided **outside** the state of Texas in the previous **five** years, you must also request a Central Registry Check from that state. **Please** *talk with your home study social worker for guidance on how to complete this.*
