

Maintenance of Vinyl Click Flooring

- 1. It is recommended that you sweep and vacuum the area immediately after installation, to remove potentially damaging grit and debris.
- 2. Further cleaning with an approved pre-finished floor cleaner is also recommended, as required.
- 3. Do not buff, wax or use cleaning products that contain surfactants. A spray mop is the most ideal cleaning tool.
- 4. Never steam clean or use a steam mop on the floor.
- 5. If you are moving and placing furniture and appliances cover all feet and floor contact points with heavy self-adhesive felt pads to protect the floor. Lift heavy objects when moving them and avoid rolling or sliding them across the floor to prevent scratching.
- 6. Felt pads on chair legs should be replaced periodically as they will wear and accumulate grit with use, which can damage the floor.
- 7. Outdoor footwear, hard-soled shoes and stiletto type heels should not be worn when walking on engineered vinyl floors, as they may mark, abrade or otherwise damage the surface and finish.
- 8. Likewise, keep pet nails trimmed, especially dogs, do not keep litter boxes or pet food or water dishes directly on the flooring and ensure any toilet training accidents are cleaned immediately.
