The priest introduces the service, and then the following responsory is said:

*The priest pronounces absolution, to which all respond: **Amen.***

Hymn

Collect

*The priest says the Collect, to which all respond: **Amen.***

Readings, Eulogy, and Sermon

Genesis 2.3-9, Psalm 23

The eulogy is given.

The Priest delivers the Homily.

Hymn

The hymn All Things Bright and Beautiful (CP251) is sung.

Prayers

The priest leads the people in prayer, and then introduces the Lord's Prayer:

PRIEST As our Saviour Christ has commanded and taught us, we are bold to say:

ALL **Our Father, who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come;
thy will be done;
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation;
but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom,
the power and the glory,
for ever and ever.
Amen.**

The priest commends Jane to God, and commits her body for cremation.

At the end of each prayer, all say: Amen.

Dismissal

PRIEST Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord.

ALL **And let light perpetual shine upon her.**

PRIEST May her soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

ALL **Amen.**

Hymn

The hymn Amazing Grace (CP375) is sung.

The priest pronounces the final blessing, to which all respond: Amen.

The priest dismisses the people.

PRIEST Go in the peace of Christ.
