## **ORDINANCE 2005-2**

## DILAPIDATED HOUSES BROUGHT INTO THE TOWN OF GORDON

THIS ORDINANCE PROHIBITS THE BRINGING IN AND SETTING UP OF OLD DILAPIDATED HOUSES WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF GORDON, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF GORDON, ALABAMA THAT THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY ADOPTED.

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for anyone to bring into the city limits of the Town of Gordon, any houses that are dilapidated.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for anyone to bring into the city limits the Town of Gordon, any houses or dwellings that have been condemned by any other town, city or housing authority.

Section 3: Anyone who brings any type of dwelling into the city must purchase a permit before bringing in.

Section 4: The council must approve any permit before its issuance.

Section 4: Anyone in violation of this ordinance shall be fined \$300.00 for the first offense and \$500.00 for the second and subsequent offenses.

Section 5: The property owner where dwellings are situated upon shall be held responsible.

Section 6: This ordinance is severable and each part thereof is hereby adopted separately. If for any reason any part of it is declared invalid, then the remaining parts shall remain in full force and effect.
