Intro: Spring is on the way. There are signs of it already.

Spring reminds us of a truth – God changes everything.

Rev. 21:5 – "the One seated on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new."

1 - God changes nature.

Amos 5:8 – "He turns darkness to dawn and daylight to darkness;" No sunset or sunrise is exactly the same.

Tide is constantly changing. Earth is constantly spinning. Change/constant. God's design is for change to happen.

- **Gen. 8:22** "As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night shall never cease."
 - What is constant in life is change.

2 - God changes people.

Fishermen to disciples: Peter & Andrew; James & John Dishonest tax collector to disciple: Matthew. 1st Gospel of N.T. Joseph's brothers have regret and guilt for what they did.

- **Gen. 50:18** – they "came and bowed down to the ground in front of him and said, "We are your slaves." They are who sold him as a slave...

Jesus' brother James - From crazy & cynical to follower & figurehead

- **John 7** his brothers told him to go to Judea so all could see what he was doing. "Not even his brothers believed in Him."
- Mark 3:21 His family thought "He's out of his mind."
 - o God can change the people in our lives, too. Prodigals go home.
 - o Wanderers settle down. Immaturity grows up.
 - o Addiction becomes recovery. Advocates start as addicts.
 - o Junkie to Judge. Mary Beth O'Connor. Fed Admin Law judge

3 - God changes situations.

Joseph went from the pit to the palace. Gen. 37-40

Peter went from sitting in the hoosegow to walking to a house. Acts 12

David went from being on the run to running Israel.

Esther went from orphan, living with Uncle Mordecai, to Queen.

Ruth went from mourning to dancing. She chose love. Not bitter. "Mara"

- God changed her situation: from Moab to Bethlehem. Marries Boaz.

- God makes unpassable seas become hallways of water a passageway to Promised land . . . He can change your situation!
- God makes crooked placed straight; He levels mountains & breaks iron bars... Nothing is too hard.
- Your situation is not permanent. Change is coming.
 - o Bad to Good... Good to Better. But what if the change seems awful?
 - 8:28 promise "God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God"
 - Joseph could go from family to a pit to prison palace.
 - Why David lived in the palace on the run back to palace.
 - God Changes Everything ... & will ultimately be for good.
 - Dan. 2:21 "He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others."
 - When it's your time . . . in God's perfectly ordered time . . . He will raise you up.
 - 1 Peter 5:6 "Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time."

4 - God changes us.

We pray for God to change circumstances, others ... He changes US.

- "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation." Amplified: We are "reborn and renewed by the Holy Spirit; the old things [the previous moral and spiritual condition] have passed away. Behold, new things have come [because spiritual awakening brings a new life]."

Lose the anger, like John. Stop being a deceiver, like Jacob.

No longer tormented by 7 demons, Mary Magdalene

No longer blind or lame. Once was lost, now am found.

- Sometimes we repeat the same problems ... a lesson to learn.
- We become more patient, gentle, merciful, kind ... like the Father.
 - We can change b/c Holy Spirit is at work in us.
 - Saul, anointed by Samuel "the Spirit of the LORD will rush upon you
 . . . and you will be transformed into a different person." 1 Sam 10:6
 - We are being changed. Spring reminds us of that truth. Blooming is happening.
