### Dealing with Bad Day – March 8, 2023

We all have bad days. Famous, wealthy people have bad days.

Marilyn Monroe: an American actress, model, major sex symbol. Pin up girl. Aug. 5, 1962, found dead in Los Angeles, Cal home. Died from an overdose of barbiturates—drugs used to treat anxiety or sleep disorders. She had a history of depression; attempted suicide several times in the past. 36.

**Robin Williams**: actor & comedian. Academy Award for Good Will Hunting Aug. 11, 2014, found dead at his home in Cal; hanged himself with a belt from a doorknob. Surprising ... a famous, positive, & happy person; but those close to him knew he had battled depression for years. 63

**Kate Spade**: designer, businesswoman. June 5, 2018, found dead in her Park Avenue apartment in Manhattan, New York City. Hanged herself with a scarf on a doorknob. Left a 13-year-old daughter. 55.

**Cheslie Kryst:** model, attorney, and Miss USA 2019 (first AA). Graduated law school, attorney, journalist, nom. 2 Daytime Emmy Awards. Was married. Jan. 30, 2022, she jumped to her death from 60-story bldg., Manhattan. 30

**Naomi Judd**: singer. Died April 30, 2022, killed herself w/ gun at Tenn home. The Judds had 14 No. 1 hits. Naomi died the day before she and Wynonna were inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame. 76.

**tWitch** – dancer/dj on Ellen show. Died Dec. 13, 2022 in an LA hotel. Had a wife, and 3 kids. 40.

**Kyle Jacobs**, husband of Kellie Pickler. Songwriter. Died Feb 17. 49. 2 days earlier, celebrated a Lee Brice album being certified platinum.

On Avg, 132 suicides a day. Suicide – 3d leading cause teens.

### Bible has stories just like this

Bible doesn't use "depression" ... uses words like: "downcast," "brokenhearted," "troubled," "miserable," "despairing," and "mourning" **David** – "Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God." **Ps. 42:11** 

"My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear." Ps. 38:4

David struggled. Loss of child w/Bathsheba; Uriah dead.
 Moses - "But now, please forgive their sin – but if not, then blot me out of the book you have written." Exodus 32:32

- Felt like he had failed. Ready to quit.

**Elijah** – great prophet. Fled from Jezebel... a day's journey into wilderness, sat under a broom tree, prayed: *"I have had enough, Lord," he said. "Take my life, for I am no better than my ancestors who have already died."* – **1 Ki. 19:4** 

- Fear. God sent an angel, new mission.

Jeremiah – another prophet. Didn't marry, no kids. Lived alone, poor.

He was ridiculed, rejected by people he loved, reached out to.

- Jer. 20:14 "I curse the day I was born! May no one celebrate the day of my birth."
- Jer. 20:18 "Why was I ever born? My entire life has been filled with trouble, sorrow, and shame."
- Jer. 15:10 "I wish I had never been born! I'm always in trouble with everyone in Judah. I never lend or borrow money, but everyone curses me just the same."
- Jonah preaches in Nineveh. People repent, God is merciful, Jonah pouts.
  Jonah 4:3 NLT "Just kill me now, LORD! I'd rather be dead than alive if what I predicted will not happen."

• Jonah sat down outside city; waited. God grew a plant, shade.

- Worm ate the plant; next day, "scorching east wind" & sun/head
- Jonah says again: "It would be better for me to die than to live." 4:8
  - Anger, wants to die. "I'm so angry I wish I were dead." 4:9

120,000 pop in Nineveh. God loves them, pleased w/ repentance
 Job – he cursed day he was born. Job 3 - Wanted it blotted off the calendar

We all have bad days. Sad. Depressed. For some, that sadness con't. How do you deal w/ those bad days? Focus on Five Truths.

### 1 – Your value is not tied to your work/income

Your work has nothing to do w/ your WORTH. Work is a means... Moses struggled w/ results. So did Elijah, & Jonah.

Your value to God is not based on your accomplishments, or job.

**2 – Purpose?** W, F, success? No - LOVE. In love, we find joy.

Our capacity/ability to love is found in God's love. Start there.

Goal: Love yourself. You are worthy of love. David.

Are you perfect? No. Been broken? Yes. A sinner? Yes. All are.

You have value! Loved by God... proved your value: Jesus - cross.

# 3 – Trying to do what's right... Overwhelmed? Nothing will change?

God's answer to Jeremiah – "I will take care of you." Jer. 15:11

- People will fight you. "They will not conquer you, for I am with you to protect and rescue you." Jer. 15:20
- **Period or ;** 2d half of Job's life blessed more than 1<sup>st</sup>.

### 4 – Feel forgotten, rejected? You will always belong to God.

Ps 27:10 – "Even if my father & mother abandon me, the Lord cares for me."

- David & Jeremiah felt rejection by others. Never by God.
- Even Jesus. "Look, an hour is coming and has already come when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and you will leave Me all alone. Yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me." John 16:32
  - God is with you. Always. He will never forget you.
  - Isaiah 49:15-16: "Can a mother forget her little child and not have love for her own son? Yet even if that should be, I will not forget you. See, I have tattooed your name upon my palm" (TLB).
- "God is not unjust; he will not forget your work & the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them." **Heb. 6:10**
