Online Voting opens on January 1st and closes March 1st, for those wanting to vote in cash/in person, in person voting will be open for the first 30 minutes of the annual meeting in March. Submissions are from the previous years off roading experiences. Winners are presented at State Association Annual meeting. We would compile submissions as they are presented and share them on the website. Reminders will be sent to all association club members that voting starts January 1st. Each board member will provide a trophy for their category. Trophy would need to fit into a 12x12x12 box. Trophy would need to be family friendly. Introduce trophies at the October meeting. Under 100 words for each submission.

Procedures Manual – Because we are all in volunteer positions if a board member is traveling to represent the association that board member would be reimbursed travel expenses. We would reference the current IRS guidelines around reimbursements. We would create travel expense guidelines that are realistic to current costs and expenses. Curtis proposed that we include a clause that allows association leadership to attend a percentage of member club meetings. The board would act accordingly and have those in the region be the first to attend if available. We will ask that the presidents council share their thoughts.

Counter Top Brochure: We can solicit the clubs for pictures and images to use. Corrie has pics from the Boulder Basin event that we can use. Each of us will solicit some pictures from our clubs that would be ok to use. Tammie will ask Cory Akin at the SRO meeting about a pic of him out wheeling in his ATV.
