

The return of witchcraft, and the closely related rise of holistic medicine, demonstrates that people know that the current approach to healthcare fails us in many ways. The world is evolving, and witches and other healers, are leading the return of the true medicine. Of course, the true medicine never disappeared. It was being practiced all along by witches and other healers, who learned to practice outside of the glare of the watchful eyes of the powerful. We also learned to adapt the useful parts of their medicine for our healing.

Desperate For True Medicine

We are desperate for the true medicine that witchcraft can offer. This is why so many horribly damaged people turn to witchcraft for help. It is why my inbox is full of those in need of healing. If you are suffering, know that witchcraft, the true kind that draws you inward to heal the shadow and retrieve the soul, may be your cure.

This is not the pseudo healing offered by a pill, nor is it found in a ball of white light. The only way out of hell is through it. Excessive clinging to the light not only avoids the darkness where healing resides but can burn us to ash.

We have always been the wild ones they sought to control. No wonder that their medicine rarely works on us. Witches are different, right down to our DNA. It is the poison that heals, and the power of the natural world. This medicine is not found in the halls of corporations, but by returning to Hekate's Garden where the keys to our healing are found.



The Key to Entering Hekate's Garden

I am so blessed to have Judika Illes as my editor. She is a wise mentor, giving excellent advice and support. This come about when I synchronously ran into Amy Blackthorn at Mystic South. We were instant kindred. Amy contacted Judika, who is her editor, and the rest is history.

Weiser Books wanted proposals from me ASAP after the initial conversation I had with Judika, who works for them. I mentioned to her that, of the proposed books, Entering Hekate's Garden would require the most work due to the nature of the book. I knew even as we discussed this that this was the book they would want from me. And so it was. I begin all my projects with a magickal template, such as this outline for what became EHG.



Animara Chthonia: Deathwalking Oil and Ritual

This ritual is designed to break you free of the chains that bind, building upon the lessons in EHG.

Hekate, Circe, and Medea, Triple Goddesses of Magick, Medicine, and Mystery.

You are the darkness, and you are the light. Grant me the death of the chains that bind me, freeing me to walk in your world of spirits. Reveal to me your magick, medicine and mystery.

Hekate, Great Queen, she who is the primal source who holds the keys of magick, medicine and mystery.

Hekate, Great Queen, bestow upon me the key to the world of spirits. Open the gate.

Hekate, Great Queen, shine your torches upon my path.

Circe and Medea, Eternal Witches, Daughters of Hekate, guide me. Share with me your knowledge of the world of spirits. Release me from my physical form, bring me safely back when the time comes.

Circe, Great Queen, You hold the secrets of transformation, and know the stories of the dead.

Medea, Great Queen, You possess the powers of life and death, and know the mysteries of deathwalking.

Brimo Eneroi, Fiercest Goddesses, I seek only your healing and wisdom.

Deae Rixipyle, Break the chains that bind my mind and imprison my soul.

Liberate me as I walk in the world of spirits.

Enodia, guide my way.

Lampadios, Shine your torches upon my journey, reveal to me your wisdom through visions of the spirits.

Psychopomps, Chthonias, Lampadios, guide me.

Hail Hekate.

Hail Circe.

Hail Medea.

This ritual evokes Hekate, Circe and Medea to guide you on a journey to meet with ancestors of spirit and flesh.

The dark time of the year is the perfect time for deathwalking in the spirit world. When we leave our physical bodies behind to journey as our eternal soul self, we enter a type of death; the old ego dies as we receive the medicine of the spirits. Deathwalking provides us with the opportunity to better understand the magick, medicine, and mystery of the Triple Goddesses and their world of spirits. If you are new to this sort of witchery, proceed with caution. I suggest contacting a beloved departed for your first time walking on the other side.

The Power of the Crossroads

At this crossroads, *The end of a long journey. I am no longer seduced by the past.* Nor am I fooled by the hollow promise of the well-lit path. It is the deepest darkness that I seek. Guided only by distant torch light. The Mistress of Souls, my only companion. Each step has been my own. I am here to reclaim what is mine. Pieces of me that found refuge in her dark womb. After the cruelty and violence, Of those who preyed on my weakness. They are dead to me now. Slain by my will to heal. How her Wheel has turned. Now I keep my own keys. This witch has come home. Into the welcoming darkness I tread.

The crossroads is the symbolic gateway to the world of spirits. We find crossroads throughout the natural world, where paths meet, at the juncture of land, sea, and sky. Swamps, marshes, and entrances to caves are considered crossroads. Find your crossroads and bring some of Hekate's Feast as an offering on the night of the Dark Moon (astrological new moon). Offerings have been left at the crossroads to Hekate for at least 2,500 years. Also called deipna Hekates (Deipnon singular) and were also known as Hekataia or Hekatesia were offerings left at the crossroads every month for Hekate in various parts of the ancient Mediterranean.

"When planning a rite at a crossroads, determine how the energy of a specific location will factor into what you are doing. Determine if there are natural correspondences of Hekate in the environment. For example, oak is sacred to Hekate, so finding a threeway crossroads with an oak tree nearby can be considered very special. If you are

working with Hekate as Guardian, you may want to find a crossroads that reflects Under World energy. Finally, you can add lunar energy to the location by planning your ritual during a suitable part of the moon phase. You can bring items to the crossroads to heighten the energy by selecting from the correspondences discussed earlier. I generally do my workings at the crossroads of land, sea, and sky because I live right on the coast and have access to remote places free from the built environment.

If you can't easily get to such a place, you can use the end of your driveway as a three-way crossroads and do your workings there. If this is not available for you, then create your own indoor three-way crossroads using dirt from such a location. This can be done either as part of your altar, or you can create a temporary one. To do the latter, lay a black cloth on the floor and then arrange your crossroads. When you are finished with your working, you can bundle it up and store the portable crossroads until you need it again. You know by now that the cloth and dirt should be magically prepared before use. Store the dirt in a clean container that you leave outside or near a windowsill if it has come from a high-traffic area. If you appropriated the dirt from a secluded crossroads, then it is most likely fine to use right away. You'll be able to tell if the dirt is ready for magic or placing on your altar."

Asters are often found along the roadside and are fabulous offerings. Look for them to appear as the Autumn Equinox draws nigh.



FORMULARIA: Index of Pharmakeia Preparations

Blend Two or more botanicals macerated together.

Bundle A collection of stemmed botanicals bound together for burning.

Charm One botanical worn as an amulet.

Concentrate Decoction, infusion, oil, or philter that has a high ratio of materia to

water or fixative. Can be diluted.

Cream Adding botanicals to a based such as coconut oil or shea butter.

Decoction The process of boiling botanicals for several minutes. Best for

tougher plants, roots, seeds.

Dressed candle A candle activated with botanicals using various methods, usually

involving the application of a fixative to a dried blend.

Essence The liquified steam collected during an extended period of low-

boiling or the condensation collected over time in a closed jar.

Fixative An oil, liquid or solid, used as the basis for an oil or ointment.

Incense Botanicals prepared for burning.

Infusion Steeping of botanicals in boiled water. Best for softer plants and

herbs.

Infused oil Botanicals steeped in a fixative oil for several days or gently heated

over several hours.

Magickal ink

Ink infused with botanicals.

Ointment Botanicals mixed into a more solid fixative, such as shea butter, for

topical use.

Oxymel Botanicals infused in honey and vinegar.

Paquet Botanicals placed in a corresponding color cloth or bag. Also called a

sachet.

Philter A finished preparation with all botanical residue filtered out using a

fine strainer such as multiple layers of cheesecloth, usually made by combining several types of preparations (e.g., oils and decoctions).

Potion Any liquid preparation solely for magickal purposes.

Poultice Botanicals combined into a paste using a solid fixative or fabric

applied topically.

Ritual Bath Soak in the tub or shower that uses preparations to connect with the

sacred.

Scrub Botanicals combined with activated charcoal, salt, or sugar for

cleansing.

Simple A preparation made using one botanical.

Smoke The molecules released when botanicals are burned.

Steam The released molecules of oils, decoctions, etc. that are boiled. More

aggressive than vapor.

Talisman A combination of botanicals and other objects crafted into an

amulet.

Tincture Preparation of botanicals in high-proof alcohol.

Vapor The released molecules of oils, decoctions, etc. that are gently

warmed.

Wash Diluted infusion or decoction used for cleansing.

Water Made without heat to release the botanical's properties, often using

fresh herbs. Done over a period, often using lunar or solar energy.



Acetum: Vinegar.

Agia: sacred rites.

Analgesic: A botanical that reduces pain.

Anima Mundi: the universal essence within all creation. Literally translates as "World

Soul."

Animarum Aqua Sibylla: Ritual bathing to induce prophecy.

Animarum Corpus: Embodied rituals, where the physical being plays a central role, or a

ritual celebrating the physical self.

Animarum Initio: An initiation ritual.

Animarum Pharmaka Gnosis: Ritual for experiencing the mystery of plant spirits.

Animarum Pyriphoitos: Spiritual firewalking ritual.

Animarum Sacris: Ritual for banishing the harmful.

Animarum Viridis: Ritual for experiencing the mystery of the Green World.

Animarum: all sacred activities, including preparing botanicals for use, spells,

meditations, and rituals.

Antibacterial: Reducing or killing bacteria.

Antidepressant: Relieving depression.

Antifungal: A botanical that treats fungal infections.

Antiseptic: Reducing or stopping the spread of harmful microorganisms.

Antitussive: Relieves coughing.

Antiviral: Reducing or stopping the spread of viruses.

Anxiolytic: Reducing feelings of anxiety.

Apothecary: The plants, tools, objects, and supplies used in plant spirit witchcraft.

Aqua: Water.

Archetype: A primal force or spirit.

Aromative: A botanical whose medicine is released through its scent.

Aspect: To allow a spirit or deity to use us as a vessel.

Astringent: Used on the skin, based in water or alcohol, that cleanses, reduces oil, and tightens pores.

Astrodia: Goddess of the Stars, representing the Upper World.

Astrodic Pharmakeia: Botanicals with properties and essences connected primarily to intellect, knowledge, and mysticism.

Astrodic: Of the Upper World, representing intellect and mysticism.

Attunement: The process of aligning an essence with another one.

Audere: To dare. One of the Septum Novum.

Binding: The process of magickally rendering spirits joined.

Blend: To allow a spirit or deity to become part of our physical or spiritual selves.

Book of Life: The sacred records of a witch. Also known as The Book of Shadows or a grimoire.

Botanical: Any bush, flower, herb, plant, or tree.

Chronos: Chronological time.

Chthonia: Goddess of the Under World.

Chthonic Pharmakeia: Botanicals with properties and essences that are strongly associated with emotions, healing, and the womb.

Chthonic: Of the Under World, representing emotions and the womb of the Goddess.

Command: To instruct a spirit to perform a certain way. Best used with lower-order spirits.

Corporeal: having physical form.

Corporeality: our experiences in the material world.

Correspondences: Beings, objects, symbols, and other entities that share energetic and/or physical properties with a botanical.

Credere: To know. One of the Septum Novum.

Deathwalking: Leaving the corporeal self to walk in the world of spirits. The spiritual death of the self, whether temporary or enduring.

Digestive: Aids digestion.

Diuretic: Increasing urinary function.

Emetic: Inducing vomiting.

Emmenagogue: Increasing and stimulating menstrual flow.

Enodia: Goddess of the Road, representing the Middle World.

Enodic Pharmakeia: Botanicals with properties and essences that are strongly associated with action and the material world.

Enodic: Of the Middle World, representing actions, the interface between the unseen and seen and the ensuing material world.

Essence: The soul and eternal, etheric properties of an object.

Ethereality: the very real experiences had in the World of Spirits.

Evocation: To petition the presence of a spirit or deity.

Expectorant: A botanical that encourages release of phlegm.

Fixative: The based used to stabilize and activate botanicals.

Formularia: A collection of botanical products.

Formularium: Botanical products, such as incenses or tinctures.

Gnosis: practical knowledge.

Green World: both the physical and spiritual natural world.

Hieros Pyr: Sacred fire; the essential spark used to activate and release plant spirits.

Icon: a symbolic representation of the perceived appearance of a spirit or deity.

Inflammation: A response of the body including swelling, soreness, and redness as a response to underlying infection or disease.

Initiation: the process of evaluation to determine suitability for proclaiming proficiency as a pharmaka and the ensuing ceremony.

Invoke: To call a spirit or deity into ourselves.

Ire: To go. One of the Septum Novum.

Kairos: Eternal cycles and time. The Wheel of Time and The Wheel of the Year.

Khernips: The ritual process of merging water, fire, and plant spirits for banishing.

Kleis Viridis: The key to entering the magick, medicine and mystery of the Green World.

Kleis: Literally means "key." Used to indicate a foundational concept or practice.

Kolossos: A magickal effigy (also known as a poppet).

Layering: The considered combination of multiple botanicals and/or other correspondences to amplify the power of a spell or other working.

Loci: position or place.

Magic: the general spirit of the universal essence, see also "Anima Mundi."

Magick: intention use of plant spirits for creating spells.

Magikeia: the practice of magick.

Maleficarum Saccharo: Sugar syrup based botanical preparations.

Maleficarum: Witchcraft.

Materia: Physical botanical matter.

Medicine: the physiological and spiritual properties of plants that correct imbalance and soothe dis-ease of the mind, body, and soul.

Merge: To share consciousness with a spirit or deity.

Mystery: the purely spiritual experience of plant medicine.

Naturalis: Using plant spirits without altering them.

Necromancy: Summoning the spirits of the ancestors.

Nervine: Calming to the nervous system.

Noscere: To believe. One of the Septum Novum.

Offering: Any object presented as a gift to a spirit or deity.

Oleum Moirai: Oil of The Fates. Psychic anointing oil.

Oleum: Oil.

Oversoul: The archetypal spirit from which all specific representations of the spirit flow.

Petition: To speak to a spirit or deity with an intention of gaining their assistance or favor.

Pharmaka: a practitioner of plant spirit witchcraft

Pharmakeia Acetum: Vinegar based botanical preparations.

Pharmakeia Aqua: Water based botanical preparations, such as infusions and decoctions.

Pharmakeia Lucerna: Botanical candle magick.

Pharmakeia Oleum: Oil based botanical preparations.

Pharmakeia Pyriphoitos: Trance inducing plant spirits used for spiritual firewalking.

Pharmakeia Vocatus: Alcohol based botanical preparations.

Pharmakeia: the practice of plant spirit witchcraft

Pharmakoi Kyrios: Master Plant Spirit Teachers.

Philter: any plant spirit preparation with a base of a combination of water, oil, vinegar,

or alcohol.

Poppet: A magickal effigy (also known as a poppet).

Practica: "Doing" plant spirit witchcraft.

Praeparatio: Preparation.

Properties: The physiological and spiritual characteristics of a botanical.

Psychopomp: A guide for the departed.

Psychopompery: The practice of guiding the departed.

Purgative: A botanical with a laxative effect.

Ratio: The system or organization.

Regina Maleficarum: Queen or Goddess of Witchcraft. Hekate.

Regina Pharmakeia: Queen or Goddess of Plant Spirit Witchcraft. Circe.

Regina Venificarum: Queen or Goddess of the Poison Path. Medea.

Regina: Queen or Goddess.

Relic: any sacred object

Ritual: The process of entering the unseen world, the deeper Garden of the Goddess, through activities and altered states of consciousness.

Sedative: Inducing or improving sleep.

Sentire: To feel. One of the Septum Novum.

Septum Novum: the seven primal forces of the four elements and three worlds.

Sibylika: the practice of divination.

Sophia: spiritual wisdom.

Spell: The use of energetic techniques to create a spirit that seeks to achieve the indicated outcome.

Stimulant: A botanical that raises the functioning of the nervous system.

Summon: To intentionally call upon a spirit or deity.

Sympathetic magick: The use of an enchanted object to impact the person or spirit that it is connected to.

Synergetics: creating a unified whole much greater than the sum of the individual parts.

Tacere: To be silent. One of the Septum Novum.

Talisman: an object enchanted with magick or full of spiritual medicine.

Tonic: A formulation, usually in the form of a decoction, infusion or tincture, that encourages overall wellness.

Trance: Using plant spirit medicine (and other techniques) to enter altered states of consciousness to experience the deeper Garden of the Goddess and the world of spirits.

Velle: To will. One of the Septum Novum.

Venificarum: The poison path; the study and use of noxious botanicals for witchcraft.

Vibration: The energetic frequency at which an object resonates.

Vibrational essence: The basic energetic frequency of the soul of an object.

Vivification: The process of enlivening an object with a spirit or deity.

Vocatus: Alcohol.

Vox Pharmaka: The power of the practitioner's voice and thoughts.

Wildcrafting: Collection and use of botanicals that grow wild (i.e., are not grown in cultivated gardens).



