Requirements:

- Must be a senior and a member of the MHSRA
- Must be enrolling in a Community College, Trade School, or Senior College in the Fall of 2024
- Must earn a High School Diploma

The Ride for Carmen Scholarship is a one-time \$500 scholarship that can be used toward tuition, books, and/or on campus housing. There will be at least one scholarship given to a female member of the MHSRA and at least one given to a male member of the MHSRA.

This female scholarship is given in memory of Carmen Elizabeth Smith, who passed away on June 29, 2015 after suffering a traumatic brain injury. Carmen was a bright young lady who loved to cheer, play softball and ride horses. Carmen was a member of the Mid-South Little Britches Rodeo Association.

The male scholarship will be given by the Ride for Carmen organization but in memory of Bradley Fulton, a former member of the MHSRA. Bradley passed away on January 13, 2010 after losing an 8 year battle with a traumatic brain injury. Bradley also loved to ride horses and suffered his injury while competing at a high school rodeo.
