From the Pastor

Go and Make Disciples

Scripture: Matthew 28:16-20

I love history and visiting historical places I have never been to before. While in High School, I even considered becoming a history

teacher. I believe teaching history can help us better understand who we are and our society. Recently, I went to Manassas to tour the Battle of Bull Run. Shortly after the American Civil War, in

June 1865, Union troops built two obelisks "In Memory of the Patriots" who had died during the battles. These were the first monuments built after the war.

Jesus also instructed His disciples after His resurrection on top of a mountain. He states all authority has been given to Him "in heaven and on earth...." The disciples are commissioned as The Apostles, and they are to make more disciples. Jesus makes

it clear that the multiplication of followers, would be His disciples, and not the disciples of each Apostle: Peter, James, John, etc. They were Jesus' disciples, and they were to be taught everything Jesus taught the Apostles. I find this humbling as I found I want to be remembered at times for being a "good" teacher, but that isn't what is important. Pointing others to living out following Jesus is all that matters. This causes me to think of the song, "Cornerstone" by Hillsong United (see colored lyrics). These words remind me of the centrality of Jesus in every aspect of life. Jesus also promises to be with us to the end of the age, through every storm in life. Even when we are forgotten, Jesus' name will be praised, and His disciples will be changing the world!
