

## 2023 Summary of Activities

**Overview:** The mission of MetroWest Free Medical Program, Inc. is to serve as an entry point to the health care system for those who are uninsured or insufficiently insured by providing immediate health related care and connections to other health resources. We are a vital part of the health safety net. Engaging volunteers in meaningful opportunities to provide access to health care for low-income residents, particularly individuals who are immigrants, newcomers, or for whom English is not their primary language, regardless of circumstances, is the heart of our work. We are proud to have attained the 2023 GuideStar Gold Seal of Transparency as well as the 2023 National Association of Free Clinics Gold Standards Range. We have completed our first year of operations from our clinic at 246 Maple Street in Marlborough. Here is a snapshot of our impact in 2023.

## **Our Impact Patients and Clinics**

- 1,161 in-person patient visits: 537 General Medicine; 483 Women's Health; 141 Vision
- 98 in-person clinics total: 43 Women's Health; 43 General Medicine; 12 Vision
- The majority of our patients are Latinx-Brazilian-primary languages:
- ~90% Portuguese-speaking; 5% English Speaking; 4% Spanish Speaking and 2 individuals-Indonesian
- Over 53% returning patients; 40% new patients; (7% not listed)
- ullet Our onsite medical care was made possible through the generous dedication of  $\circ$  29 active volunteer providers (physicians, nurses and nurse practitioners),
  - o 12 technicians and opticians
  - 7 Administrative volunteers
  - 33 volunteer medical scribes
  - 28 interpreters (volunteer and consultants)
  - 6 part-time staff
    - + Additional generous donors, foundations, organizations, and community partners.
