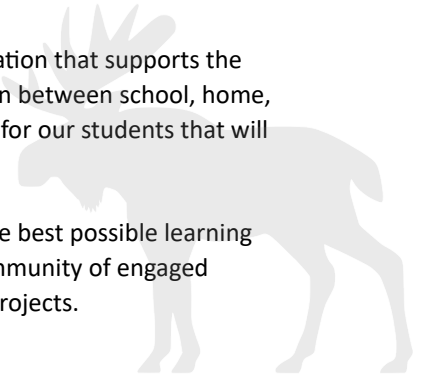

We work to create a connection between school, home, and community and aim to enhance and support amazing educational experiences for our students to help them "Dream it, Believe It, Do It!" In all, we hope to make positive contributions to our community and society through volunteer and financial support.

Because of your support, previous years we purchased items, such as over \$100,000 worth of teacher grants for their specific classroom's educational needs, books for the library and classrooms, moose garden supplies, a climbing wall, tables and shade for several outdoor learning environments, concrete blocks forming the letter "A" on the front lawn to enjoy at school and events, allocated a donation for the PTCO's start up at Elementary 45, tablets, computers with carts to house the tablets and computers, a GlowForge machine, and professional vinyl printer. This year, we are looking forward to contributing towards continuing to foster educational and social growth as well as expanding the playground with possible structures like a rope jungle gym and/or gaga ball pit.
