DENDROBIUM PARVULUM BLUE



Origin: Papua New Guinea & Sulawesi

Temperatures: Cold to intermediate growing miniature orchid species

Light: Bright light

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing year-round, only best quality water.

General care: Very desirable and highly sought-after species. This micro miniature orchid from Papua New Guinea has creeping growing habit, tiny reddish pseudobulbs that go dormant and lose leaves, and blooms on pseudobulbs with or without leaves, mostly on old leafless ones, with beautifully colored blue blooms. This Dendrobium can grow in variety of temperature conditions, it is described as warm growing but does best when grown intermediate to cool, very bright light (we grow them right under strongest LED), weak fertilizing and good quality water year-round. They like higher humidity but they like to dry out between waterings. Can be grown potted or mounted, they do not like to be buried in moss but rather sitting on the top of the moss - if potted, clay pots are the best. Great plants for terrariums, vivariums, frog encounters, greenhouses or outside year-round.
