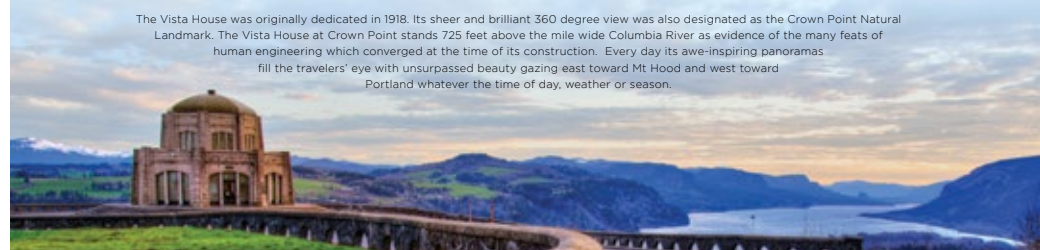
COLUMBIA RIVER GORGE NATIONAL SCENIC AREA

Of the United States within the Columbia River Gorge is the largest National Scenic Area in America. The gorge canyon lies 30 minutes east of Portland Oregon on Hwy 84 where it transitions from a vast temperate rain forest of hemlock and Douglas firs all covered in epiphytes from the west into massive rolling dry grasslands through magnificent vistas that began to form during the Miocene era roughly 17 to 12 million years ago. The peaks of the Cascade Mountains that rise from sea level to 4000' generating a wind tunnel effect with a diverse collection of ecosystems in the northernmost border of Oregon while viewing the south side of the river. The notable Multnomah Falls at 620 feet is among more than 90 pristine waterfalls in these Oregon mountains with the spray and splash of glorious spilling waterways as they cascade their way into the great Columbia River.

Additionally, two historic sites within the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area are architectural landmarks in America's story as it unfolded during their construction early in the 20th century. These are: the Multnomah Falls Lodge and the Vista House at Crown Point.

Completed in 1925, Multnomah Falls Lodge was built by the City of Portland after the land was donated through a series of owners. They ultimately made it possible for millions of visitors year after year to enjoy this national treasure. It has become a magnificent destination spot for respite to relish in the spectacular views of the water fall and its grounds. The paved path up to the Benson Bridge offers stunning scenes of the Columbia River Gorge as well.

The Vista House was originally dedicated in 1918. Its sheer and brilliant 360 degree view was also designated as the Crown Point Natural Landmark. The Vista House at Crown Point stands 725 feet above the mile wide Columbia River as evidence of the many feats of human engineering which converged at the time of its construction. Every day its awe-inspiring panoramas fill the travelers' eye with unsurpassed beauty gazing east toward Mt Hood and west toward Portland whatever the time of day, weather or season.
