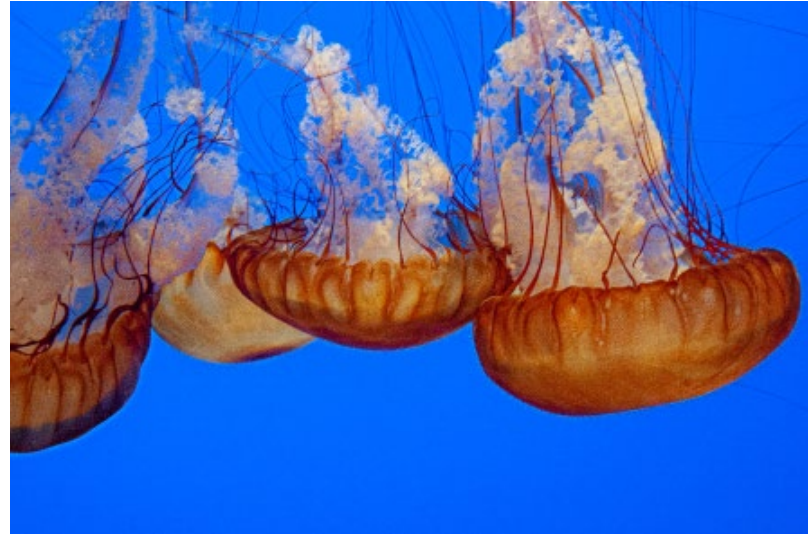

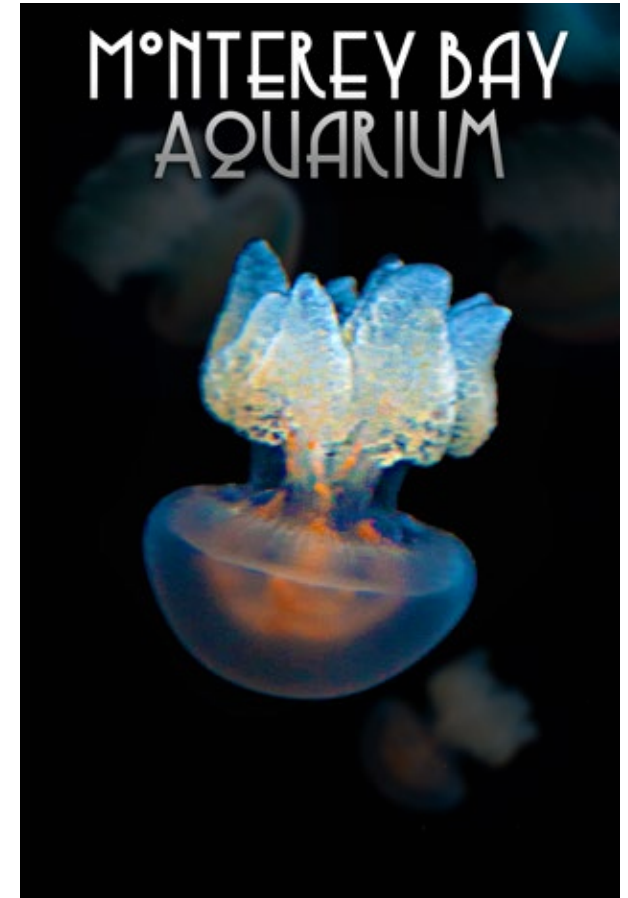

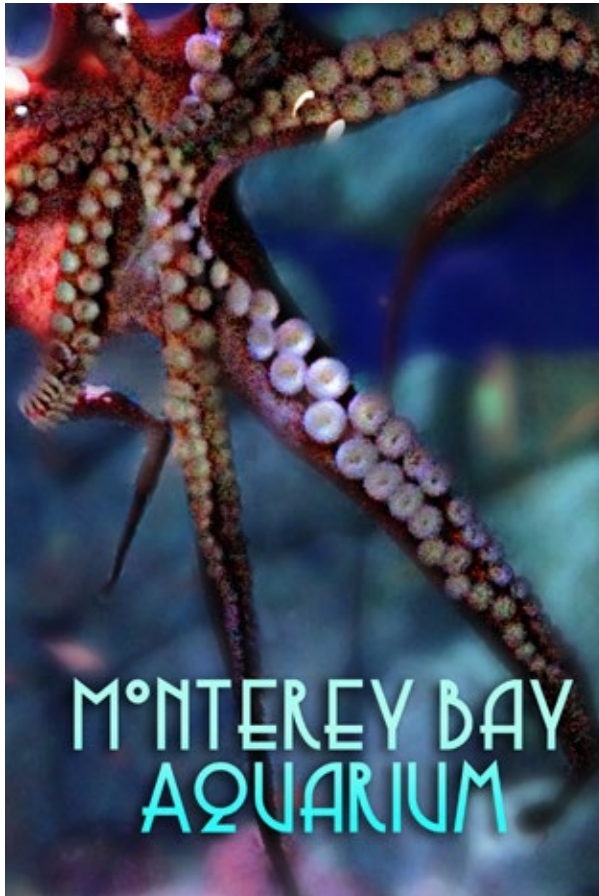

As an architectural design award winner and exhibitor of marine life, MBA is one of the premier attractions of Monterey County where it emphasizes ocean conservation through its many art pieces and educational programs. An intricate seawater system pumps filtered seawater through the Kelp Forest and other exhibits by day and raw seawater by night. The bubble-wall beneath the viewing window protects fast swimming species from accidentally banging against the glass when dark. MBA became the first Great White Shark exhibitor to keep A Great White alive longer than 16 days. Six Great Whites were shown in the Open Sea Exhibit from 2004-2011. Rescued sea otters are the only marine mammals displayed. Cetaceans and killer whales can be viewed as they travel through the Monterey Bay from MBA's ample decks along the back of the building.
