
THE JALOWIEC FAMILY MISSIONARIES TO ZAMBIA

Bore Holes

The last rains were in April and the dry season is fully upon us. Now is the Time to DRILL!



So many villages have no fresh water source. Many have to rely on streams and ponds which by this time of the year are dried up. Our goal is to provide a fresh water well for each church planted as a result of the ministry of Grace and Truth Zambia. We are so thankful for partners in this goal!

We have a drilling rig set to go out to Mpeta Village, about 80 km deep into the bush. Dozens of families will benefit from this well! This will go a long way in showing the Love of Christ, as well as soften peoples hearts to hearing of the Spring of Living water that can heal their soul!

There are many challenges to drilling. New government policies, permits and other red tape, as well as finding fresh water! Many times the drill comes up dry, which not only costs extra, but can be so discouraging! Please be praying for the well in Mpeta, plus the funding for other locations we are hoping to be able to drill!

Bikes

Transportation in the village is always a challenge, and we are praying to be able to supply more bicycles as well as a a couple of motorcycles to make it possible to deliver the Gospel more readily into the deeper bush regions. Travel time on foot ONE WAY to some of our churches is 5 hours, and in some of the most extreme weather and heat. Pray we can source and fund these necessary ministry tools!
