We have had lots of new starters this month and it has been lovely to see them settling in, their confidence growing and building relationships with their key worker.

### **Toddler Room**

The toddlers have enjoyed their trip to the beach where they had fun building sandcastles, jumping in puddles and having a picnic lunch. The toddlers have also enjoyed playing outside in the sunshine with the hoops and footballs and practicing their gross motor skills. They have had a keen interest in playing in the home corner developing their imaginative skills by cooking lunch and feeding the babies.

## **Early Learners Room**

This month we have enjoyed spending time outdoors. We have got very competitive in our eggs and spoon race. While outdoors we have enjoyed water pay, filling up buckets and running through the sprinkler. The children have shown an interest in colours and we have explored colours by mixing with the paints and going on a colour hunt. We have welcomed 'Adventure bear, into early learners, he has already had some very busy weekends with some of our children and the children have enjoyed looking at this at nursery and recalling their experiences.

## **Pre-School Room**

Pre school have had a busy month! We have had our graduation ceremony for our preschool leavers – celebrating their next adventure of starting reception and nursery school. We also held a sports day which was great fun, the children were split into teams and were very good at following instructions and showed great control of their movements. Children have been confident in discussing their experiences outside of nursery and we have created a hairdressers following children's experiences and interests. We have also looked at the bones in the human body and made skeletons with black playdough and cotton buds after the children were discussing X- rays.
