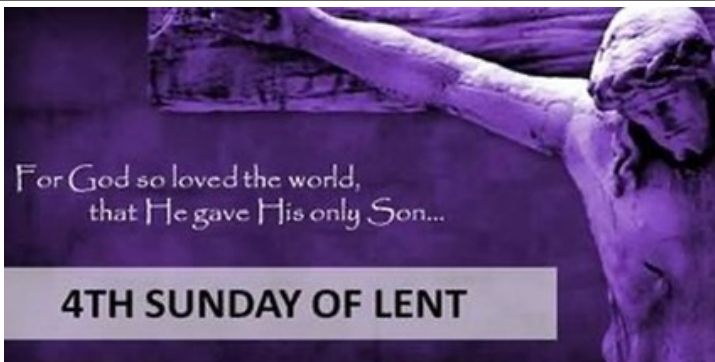

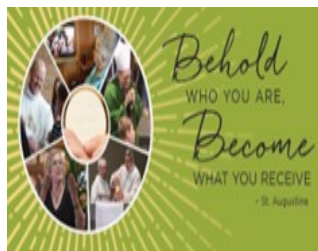

## Bishop's Invitation to Diocesan Synodal Listening Sessions in March

Bishop Neary has indicated that one of his priorities is to engage in "synodality" -- a process of encountering, listening to, and

walking with one another, that he has shared "is rooted in the life and ministry of Jesus". Pope Francis is encouraging all of the dioceses in the US – and around the world – to engage in conversations about key questions that emerged in the Synod gathering at the Vatican this past October. **Our diocese is offering a couple of in-person synodal listening sessions – Sat, March 9<sup>th</sup> (9:30 am – 1 pm; at Immaculate Conception parish in Rice), and Sat, March 23<sup>rd</sup> (9:30 am – 1 pm; at Our Lady of Victory parish in Fergus Falls).** There are also two Zoom sessions – Mon, March 11<sup>th</sup> (7-9:30 pm) and Wed, March 13<sup>th</sup> (7-9:30 pm). These are opportunities to share your thoughts, experiences and concerns of Church life, leadership, and structures – in small groups, then in the larger group. Bishop Neary has shared that "these listening sessions will help to inform our Holy Father, but – most importantly – they will provide essential information for me and our diocese." Please join us! 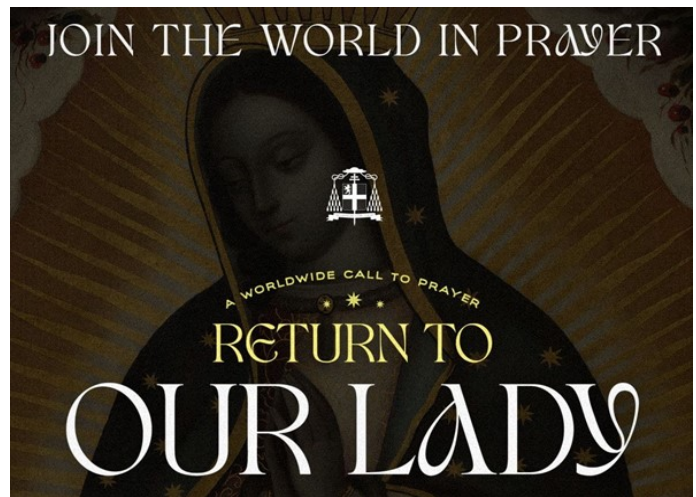
