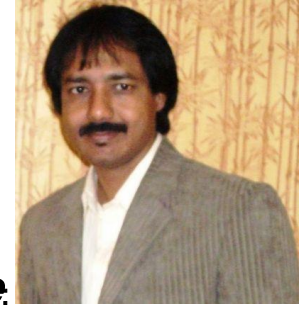

Established in 1995 under the Trust Act and also registered under FCRA, CEDRA (Centre for Education Developmental Research and Action) is a modest attempt to reach out to the poor, downtrodden and oppressed citizens to envisage an equitable and balanced society.

Technical Experience: CEDRA has implemented various relief and developmental projects for international organizations like Save the Children, Gujarat Quick Relief Coordination Committee (GQRCC), Holland, Indo-German Social Service Society (IGSSS), CARE, Help Age India and CAIRN India on Health, Education and Livelihood sectors. **Free General Health Check-up camps with free treatments in Jamnagar, Banaskantha and Patan districts**, Construction of School in Surendranagar district under earthquake rehabilitation and conducting skill building training of unemployed youth under UMEED and SKILL TO SUCCEED are some of the program under these partnerships. CEDRA has also conducted Socio Economic Impact assessment, Impact evaluation, C M &E, Socio- Economic Survey, **Training and Capacity building programme on Micro Entrepreneurship Development (MED), SHGs, Cluster development, Gender, Health etc for government organizations like GWEDC, ICDS, GGRC, GEC**, departments like Forest, Agriculture and international agencies like World Bank/IFAD, NORAD and SAP India with its technical expertise.

CEDRA has four core sectors for intervention towards holistic development.

1. Education:

CEDRA, in partnership with **IIM Ahmedabad**, carried out Social Research and FGDs with Students, Teachers and Parents to improve the learning outcomes in Government Primary Schools covering all districts of Gujarat for more than 4 years between 2015-2019. During these exercise we could interact with more than 1000 schools teachers and 10000 students alongside 300+ Scholl Management committees.

At the same time CEDRA also got exposure to Government Primary School Teachers and Children under Micro level Intervention Project with **CAIRN INDIA -VEDANTA** where nearly 200+ schools were benefitted through various Sports, Culture and Competitive interventions where children were targeted towards behavioral changes in terms of good practices like Protecting Environment, Plantations, developing health seeking behavior, Developing Sportsman Spirit, using Toilets built under Swatchta Abhiyan or under any developmental schemes towards promoting health and hygiene etc.

2. Health :

CEDRA has carried out trainings of Anganwadi workers and frontline functionaries including Supervisors for ICDS and Health department of Government of Gujarat for Banaskantha, Patan, Ahmedabad, Jamnagar, Surendranagar and Rajkot districts where the focus of the training was to make the functionaries capable of fighting the challenges of malnourishment , childhood diarrhea, breast feeding and other early childhood issues .

The founder trustee of CEDRA Mr. Sanjay Vincent is well experienced in managing health programs. He has managed the DAZT project for John Hopkins University, USA as a state consultant for Gujarat and provided technical support to the State health department and project implementing agencies MI and FHI (AED-ARTS). He has also conducted and managed trainings of supervisors as a consultant to CARE India.

CEDRA founder has also managed HIV AIDS projects; Has managed National Truckers Project for TCI as a NACO consultant and provided technical support to the SACS of the states of Gujarat and Maharashtra, Union territories of, Diu- Daman and Dadara Nagar Haveli and Municipal corporations of Ahmedabad and Mumbai along with TIs of these AIDS Control Societies.

3. Community Development:

Overall goals of CEDRA intervention in various partnerships were Community Development. Community mobilization and making them aware about the opportunities leading to development was always topmost priorities of CEDRA.

Projects in Partnerships **with Quest Alliance and Nasscom Foundations** alongside **CARIN** India provided the opportunities to interact with communities including Man, Women, Adolescent and Children to inform them about the projects and mobilize them towards taking the benefits of the project activities leading to Self Development resulting in overall community Development. In all under such Skilling project we could mobilize more than 10000 Youth, Women, Girls, Avocent and Children where they were provided with the **Digital Literacy and Soft Skills** for future perspectives and necessary **Behavioral Changes** to adopt the fast moving changes in opportunities in Jobs and Business sectors to ensure self-sustainability.

4. Infrastructure:

Being a sensitized and more responsive NGO, CEDRA also rendered its services in Infrastructure sectors where a Primary School, Schools Toilets, Computer Lab, Community Based Safe Drinking Water RO Plants, Community Water Tank, Street Lights etc have been offered by providing A to Z Infrastructural support by responding to local Village Panchayats and government education departments in Villages like Bhrugupura (12 rooms School building with 8 toilets in CHUDA Limbadi blocks), VANI, NANA Ubhada, Mota Ubhdsa, Trent, Vinzuwada, Khijadiya, Suvali (Renovation and Modernization of RO Plant), and villages of Jamnagar, Patan, Rajkot and Banaskantha dist.

5. Research:

CEDRA has carried out Socio Economic Assessment for Gujarat Green Revolution co. (GGRS- a Government of Gujarat venture) for ten years in a row to check the impact of Micro Irrigation Schemes on Smalland Marginal Farmers. While carried out Education Quality Analysis for IIM Ahmedabad for 4 years towards improving Quality outcomes and also conducted Validation studies for ODF in Rajpipla dist. for IIM and UNICEF.

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1. Introduction:

Established in 1995 under the Trust Act and also registered under FCRA, **CEDRA (Centre for Education Developmental Research and Action)** is a modest attempt to reach out to the poor, downtrodden and oppressed citizens to envisage an equitable and balanced society. To empower the masses through awareness generation on issues like, education, health, livelihood, and gender and child rights with community participation besides undertaking developmental activities for their enrichment by establishing linkages with Government's, Non-Government Organization's development programmers and through Natural Resource Management, is a cherished dream of CEDRA. The Association of CEDRA with CAIRN VEDANTA is now more than a decade as first partnership came in effect in 2013 under €mli and in the same year another partnership for Community based RO plant project was done. Till then the partnership was intact.

2. Corporate Social Responsibility

CARIN OIL and GAS-VEDANTA LTD is pioneer in Social Responsibilities and always having pro approach to benefit the communities with its CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) interventions. Alongside many interventions CAIRN – SUVALI intended to serve the communities with purely grassroots approach where needs are surfaced from the locals and evaluated by the team for implementation towards holistic development. The tool chosen for the intervention is MLI (Micro level Intervention) alongside other key interventions in Education and Health. This PHC covers whole villages of Hazira Kantha Vistar (HAZIRA Costal), there is no other hospital in these 8 villages. interventions of Sports, Workshops, Prizes and Awards, Picnics and outings. Total Number of Students benefitted: 520

To Increase visibility of the Brand;

Through all above interventions and its impact, the visibility is witnessed among stakeholders and local communities. People acknowledge the activities and services of CAIRN VEDANTA in all platforms. It is always made sure that all interventions have branding as decided by the communication department or as conveyed by the CSR team; accordingly, brand is throughout visible and leaves lasting impact even after the completion of the programs or events. The holistic development approach is visible here where Education, Health and village panchayat facilities have been taken care off.

To Develop Rapport, Maintain Cordial Relationship with Local Community:

Our Key Intervention in Health at PHC have provided support for more institutional Deliveries and 24/7 medical services in Suvali Primary Health Centre under the effective leadership of local Medical Officer:

Medical Officer of Suvali PHC quotes; “VEDANTA limited Cairn oil and Gas provided 2 Medical Staff at Suvali PHC (Primary Health Centre). This PHC covers whole villages of Hazira Kantha Vistar (HAZIRA Costal), there is no other hospital in these 8 villages. Maximum patients of these villages are getting the benefits of Suvali PHC, they don’t need to go to Surat city for the treatments. All the patient of Institutional Deliveries, Family Planning Operation, and Dog Bites, Snack Bites, Accidental Injury like emergency cases are getting the emergency services here due to availability of Health Staff under CAIRN –VEDANTA intervention. In the case of Suicide, Murder, Accidental death, now we can do Postmortem within half an hour and handover the death body to families as soon as possible due to health staff provided by CAIRN-Vedanta. “

Under our periodic interventions we have provided nutritious food and other awareness to Anaganwadis and parents of anganwadi Kids in association with local ICDS and Health departments. Our interventions in Schools have motivated students in overall development through various interventions of Sports, Workshops, Prizes and Awards, Picnics and outings. Total Number of Students benefitted: 520

To Increase visibility of the Brand;

Through all above interventions and its impact, the visibility is witnessed among stakeholders and local communities. People acknowledge the activities and services of CAIRN VEDANTA in all platforms. It is always made sure that all interventions have branding as decided by the communication department or as conveyed by the CSR team; accordingly, brand is throughout visible and leaves lasting impact even after the completion of the programs or events. 3.1 Planning- Content plan for the batches of the respective months

- Content plans were given on weekly basis and it covers five week of total content delivery. Sheet is attached for ready reference as Anx 1.

3.2 Outcome/Review of the content planned for the respective months

- Since the installation of chrome books and other IT resources could be completed by 22nd November only we tried our level best to guide the trainers towards achieving the content delivery on Employability and English alongside some Digital literacy with Smart Phones and theoretical approach.

3.3 Content covered against content planned in the respective months

During field visit and virtual interaction progression over content were discussed and delivery was satisfactory considering the above facts. Mehsana has done it at their best while Himmatnagar needed some support over going ahead with content without Chrome books. They too did it and now its going smoother as all the locations have received required IT resources to carry out the content as per the weekly planning.

3.4 Achievement for the respective months

Between October and November both the districts have launched their respective batches and also started attending schools after Diwali for their School level Intervention on receiving the approval from competent authorities.

3.5 Challenges

Yes there were various challenges from different stakeholders and partners. Getting space for Training Centre was difficult task in some villages like Ghakan, Sonasana etc but it was resolved thorough due dialogues. Mobilization was also a challenge as only one mobilizer per district was not enough to do effective mobilization and start the batches in time. Vans

and Chrome books delivered bit later so trainers were finding it difficult to retain the trainees as most of them were enrolled for computer learning.

3.6 Actions taken against the challenges

Retention issue was resolved with capacity building of trainers where they were trained on soft skills and ice breaking games through Virtual trainings and this helped them engaging the communities by delivering soft skill modules.

While mobilization was effectively done by our trainers after we did their capacity building on the subject and convince them to carry out such activities which were not in their Job Scope. They did it effectively and we got required numbers of trainees enrollment.

4. Best practices if any.

Some good initiatives were taken to reach masses for Mobilization and Enrollment likewise meeting the community during Navratri celebration or dayras in the village by staying back in the village. This helped them introduced to the community and also helped in receiving women participation.

METHODOLOGY

Generally the facilitators of the CSC who put emphasis on below mentioned four key parts:

1. Mobilisation
2. Enrolment
3. Training
4. Job placement

❖ **MOBILISATION:**

Into the first batch of both CSC of Ahmedabad cities, facilitators did make blue print for the mobilisation part. It included need assessment discussion part for the targeted community, pamphlets distribution among the targeted community people, home visits with a view to searching school drop outs and counselling process, advertisement into the newspapers. Some of the targeted rural and urban community viz.

1. Ahmedabad City:-Himmatlal park, Vejalpur, vastrapur, Vasna, Jivrajpark, Satellite, Motera, Chandkhedha, Sabarmati, D-Cabin, Nearby villages of Gandhinagar, Naroda, New Nikol, Odhav, Kubernagar, Saijpur Bhoga, New Niko, Nava Vadaj, Ranip, Old Vadaj, Chandlodiya & All over Gujarat

Moreover, CSC mobilised the participants from above targeted areas with a view to furnishing quality education and escalating their inner potentialities as well as recommending income generating source or place with the principle of equality and religion, and without gender discrimination. In addition to, CSC also gave equal opportunity to the girls and widow women who had strong will to study ahead but unable on account of some circumstances.

❖ **ENROLMENT:**

Enrolment is one of the significant parts which play vital role. After completing the procedure of mobilisation, CSC scrutinised the eligible students as per the check list and then enrolled. These centres put emphasis on the part of effective counselling part before putting them into the in house training.

❖ **TRAINING:**

Once students enrolled into the centre, facilitators play key role behind facilitating the appropriate training with the mean of orientation session, furnishing knowledge of basic English and computer literacy, conducting energiser sessions and recreational sessions as well as extra curriculum activities viz. Posters making, reflection of career timeline, essays writing etc. Apart from this, facilitators made students to generate their Gmail accounts at initial stage and Linked In accounts as well as resume making at end stage, their User ID and passwords in order to enable e-learning system. At last, students put their sincere efforts behind virtual market scan and mock interview parts.

JOB PLACEMENT:

We have just completed the training batch and now focussing on employment of the trainees. CSC makes their efforts with various job placement consultancies for better job placements viz. for better job opportunities, Jm Consultancy, Radhe Developers, Suvidha Consultancy, Radhey Infra, Brand Factory and others local shops.

OUTCOME

Facilitators of CSC built strategies and appropriate plan and executed them into proper manner. It was challenging task to mobilize, enroll, and train the students into the first batch. Moreover, students of all CSC felt and admitted that how they were and how they improve at end of the batches. The students' inner zeal and readiness behind attending the class with physical and psychological presence of mind as well as participating into each and every conducted extra curriculum activity which helped to enhance life and work skills among them. They generated fire of confidence and idea of choosing appropriate career. They created self-awareness regarding their inner potentialities as well as current challenge and opportunities into the market. Additional knowledge includes understanding of decision making power, money and time management, interview facing part – these all are significant knowledge led them on appropriate path.

Project Target: To Support Vulnerable Communities in Ahmedabad and Nadiad in Gujarat, by providing dry Ration kits, Meals and Covid related Counselling Support to 1000 Families

INTRODUCTION :

As a non-profit organization CEDRA is doing Community development work for more than 25 years. During these years it has provided support to the less fortunate families and individuals whenever it was required. Whether it was a Massive earthquake of 2001 or unfortunate Riots, CEDRA always supported the effected people in relief and rehabilitation. This time Due to COVID-19 pandemic, loss of lives, jobs, business, and no work for the laborers' became a routine. It was a very difficult situation for people to take care of their families, both financially and mentally. During the second phase of Covid it was very dangerous situation in Gujarat. Many lost their Relatives, Family members and friends. So many people became Covid positive and after the negative report many people are mentally and physically depressed.

So in this situation CEDRA decided to carry out various Relief Activities like distribution of Ration Kits, Free Tiffin service, Free Oxygen services through concentrators and Oximeters for the communities in Gujarat. More than 1000 Ration kits and 1200+ tiffin were distributed to affected families and people.

Distribution of Masks and Sanitizers were also carried out among local communities residing in slums, villages and vendors dealing with public to protect and aware the people from Corona effects. CEDRA also wanted to support the real CORONA warriors like POLICE, BANK EMPLOYEES, HEALTH DEPARTMENT and GOVERNMENT- SEMI GOVERNMENTS (Local Municipal corporations) dealing with public by offering FREE MASKS, SANITIZERS and a Oximeter to extend the protection and raise awareness against the pandemic. Altogether 10000+ 3 Layers Masks, 1000+ N95 Masks and 1000+ sanitizers (100 ML) were distributed among the communities and Systems.

CEDRA tried to support all sections of the society may it be Minorities, Majorities, and local level groups helping people with their social services and people from lower middle class who are unable to bag due to social barriers but are in real need.

Under the Covid relief project with Azim Premji Foundation, CEDRA planed the following actions and completed the same in due timeline between June 2021 to August 2021. It was a 3 months relief project.

The Process:

On 3rd June 2021 CEDRA started with Mission Aasaan (making life easier), which was a noble cause to help the affected families and individuals. The Quantity and Arrangement of basic food items (grains) were decided for distribution, which could at least fulfill a month's ration under our budget. (5kg Rice, 5 kg Wheat powder, 1kg Tuber Dal, 500Gram Oil, 500 gram Chhana, 1kg soult, 200gram of Haldi, Chilly, Dhaniya powder)

Accordingly an agency was finalized and orders were given to prepare minimum One Thousands Ration Kits. All the kits were then stored and sorted according to the different areas and people to be distributed.

As per our proposal we were supposed to serve the areas of Ahmedabad, Nadiad, Jamnagar, Viramgam etc where CEDRA has its presence and have identified the needy sections of the societies like Laboures, Marignalised, helpless, widows, Job losers, and other covid affected people.

Accordingly we started from some of the pioneer villages where CEDRA initiated its activities like Moheral village and other villages of District of Nadiad where covid badly impacted alongsideng area in ahemdabad slumworki s of Odhav, Rakhiyal, Gomtipur, Vasna, Vejalpur etc where Migrant Families , mestic WorkersDo, Street vendors are residing. We also catered people living on the sidewalk , Students, Widows, Scavengers, and Laboring on the sidewalk. Our special intervention was with people who loss of jobs- businesses like Musician ,Artists ,Singers ,Photografers During all distrubtion.phase all the have staff maintained Corona Guide line the Mask also distributed With Ration Kit we have ..

Distrubition of Ration Kits :

1. Migrant Labours:

Migrant labours have badly impacted due to strict lockdown and closing of labour sites. They were unable to go back to their respective native places due to closure of transportations. Accordingly CEDRA identified some of the areas where labours were facing food issues and initiated kits distribution with the. Following are migrant labours from the different states residing near Santhal, SG Highway, Odhav etc.

2. Unemployed YOUTH :

CEDRA helped the youth who were facing crisis due to covid. Some of their parents lost jobs while many of these youth lost their jobs in these difficult conditions. 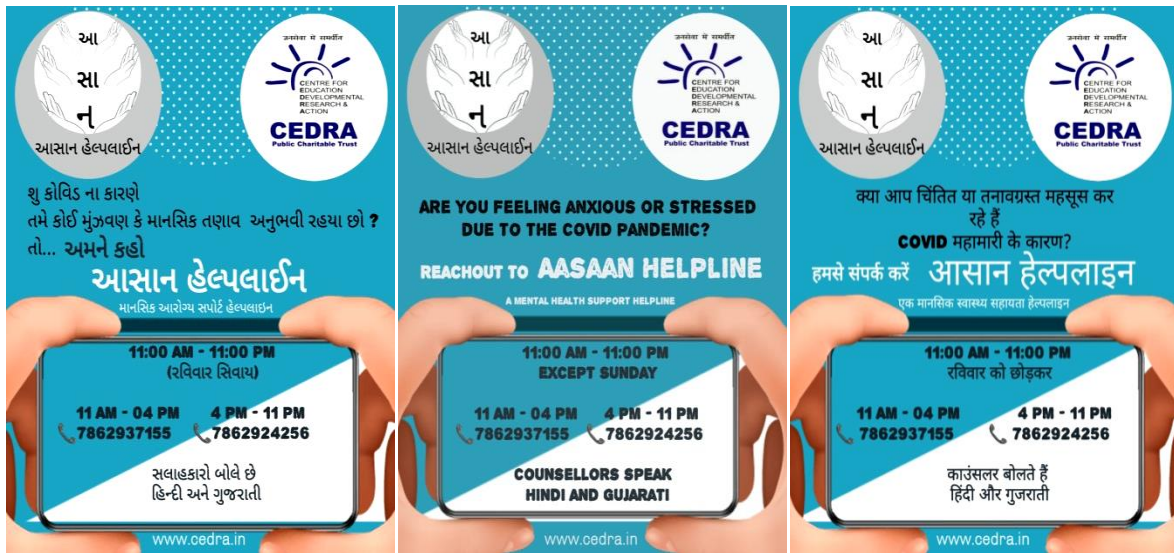
Purpose of start of this Helpline is to get people out of this situation who are anxious and stressed due to corona virus.
