The world's strategy right now is to solidify your base. Whether that is a political party, a position on moral issues, or just personal preferences – you state your case with forcefulness and you paint anyone who thinks differently or has another opinion as being the enemy. And we see the result – deep, wide, and violent division.

There has never been a time when everyone agreed on everything – after all, we are individuals with different thoughts, ideas, opinions, and priorities. But why things seem bad right now is because there is no tolerance for those differences. There's no willingness to forgive when someone makes a mistake. There's no grace when someone changes their mind. And we end up with deeply divided families (remember all the chatter about how families have been fractured over politics or Covid or vaccines throughout the holidays?), deeply divided states (red, blue, or purple?), a deeply divided nation (played on by politicians and exacerbated by the Main Street Media), and sometimes deeply divided churches.

The New Testament world was also deeply divided – so much so that there were some people who refused to associate with others...wouldn't even eat at the same table. It was so divided that they would just hurl insults at each other. But the Bible says there is one thing that bridges that divide – THE RESURRECTED JESUS! The Bible states it this way: "for he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barriers, the dividing wall of hostility..." (Eph. 2:14).

The only hope for the world is Jesus. And it is only as our identity as a Christ-follower is the most important thing in our life that we will stop trying to solidify our base by painting other people as our enemy. And it is only when we are introducing others to Christ that we might begin to see healing and unity in our churches, in our families, and in our land. I often think of it as a triangle with Christ at the top point, me at one of the side points, and another person at the other side point. As I get closer to Jesus and as the other person gets closer to Jesus, we also get closer to each other. So, to say that Jesus is the hope for the world is not just a cliché or bumper sticker statement. It is actual, Biblical truth!

The division and hostility that we see in our world today can only be healed and reconciled by Jesus. Now, I will give you the bad news first – my reading of the Bible tells me that the division and hostility will not be healed until Jesus comes again; oh, it might ebb and flow...sometimes better or worse than others, but division and hostility is here to stay until Jesus comes again. But here's the good news – Jesus is coming again and when He does, He will recreate the heavens and the earth and in our new heavenly home all hostility, anger, division, and violence will be gone.


