



# Management - Potty Training

- Puppies need to urinate immediately after waking up, so take them outside without delay.
- Eating stimulates the digestive system. Puppies normally urinate within 15 min of eating, and poop within 30 min of eating.
- Puppies need to urinate every 30 - 90 mins.

Use an “Outside” cue and take your puppy outside on a leash to a designated potty area.

Withold all attention until the puppy poops. If they puppy does not poop within 5 minutes, take them inside and try agin in 10 - 15 minutes.

Giving a cue such as “Go Potty” as the puppy is pooping allows you to place pooping on cue.

Once your dog goes potty, click and reward. Have a little play and exploration time and make a big fuss!

If outside time always ends after going potty, you may be teaching them to delay pooping/ urinating.



You may find it useful to keep a record of when your puppy eats, sleeps, urinates and poops.
