For Glass Roots Workshops

- 1. Keep long hair tied back.
- 2. Do not wear loose fitting clothing or jewelry that hang off the body.
- 3. Wear cotton or natural fibre clothing.
- 4. Do not wear open-toed or open-heeled footwear in the glass studio.
- 5. Do not use equipment without instructor present.
- 6. It can get VERY hot in the glass blowing studio. Please be prepared and arrive well hydrated with water to drink during your time in the hot shop.
- 7. We recommend bringing sunglasses for beginners, as it helps your eyes to adjust to the glass level inside the furnace.
