

#### PROCLAMATION — THANKSGIVING DAY — OCTOBER 3, 1789 By the president of the United States of America.

WHEREAS it is the duty of all nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey His will, to be grateful for His benefits, and humbly to implore His protection and favor; and whereas both Houses of Congress have, by their joint committee, requested me "to recommend to the people of the United States a day of public thanksgiving and prayer, to be observed by acknowledging with grateful hearts the many and signal favors of Almighty God, especially by affording them an opportunity peaceably to establish a form of government for their safety and happiness."

Now, therefore, I do recommend and assign Thursday, the 26th day of November next, to be devoted by the people of these States to the service of that great and glorious Being who is the beneficent author of all the good that was, that is, or that will be; that we may then all unite in rendering unto Him our sincere and humble thanks for His kind care and protection of the people of this country previous to their becoming a nation; for the signal and manifold mercies and the favorable interpositions of His providence in the course and conclusion of the late war; for the great degree of tranquility, union, and plenty which we have since enjoyed; for the peaceable and rational manner in which we have been enabled to establish constitutions of government for our safety and happiness, and particularly the national one now lately instituted; for the civil and religious liberty with which we are blessed, and the means we have of acquiring and diffusing useful knowledge; and, in general, for all the great and various favors which He has been pleased to confer upon us.

And also that we may then unite in most humbly offering our prayers and supplications to the great Lord and Ruler of Nations, and beseech Him to pardon our national and other transgressions; to enable us all, whether in public or private stations, to perform our several and relative duties properly and punctually; to render our National Government a blessing to all the people by constantly being a Government of wise, just, and constitutional laws, discreetly and faithfully executed and obeyed; to protect and guide all sovereigns and nations (especially such as have shown kindness to us), and to bless them with good governments, peace, and concord; to promote the knowledge and practice of true religion and virtue, and the increase of science among them and us; and, generally, to grant unto all mankind such a degree of temporal prosperity as He alone knows to be best.

Given under my hand, at the city of New York, the third day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine.



# DID YOU KNOW?

- In an October 5 article in *The Daily Signal*, "The BorderLine: The Border Crisis by the Numbers," it was reported that "3 million people, more or less, were 'encountered' by U.S. Customs and Border Protection . . . illegally entering the U.S. in fiscal year 2023 (which ended September 30)." This was the highest number of yearly illegal alien encounters in U.S. history.
- 2 In a post by Fox correspondent Bill Melugin on X, formerly Twitter, "Internal Customs and Border Protection (CBP) data provided & confirmed by CBP sources reveals thousands of 'special interest aliens' from mostly Middle Eastern countries have been apprehended by Border Patrol while crossing into U.S. illegally over last 2 years. Syria: 538, Yemen: 139, Iran: 659, Iraq: 123, Afghanistan: 6,386, Lebanon: 164, Egypt: 3,153, Pakistan: 1,613, Mauritania: 15,594, Uzbekistan: 13,624, Turkey: 30,830. . . . Border Patrol sources tell me they have extreme concerns about who is coming into the country because they have little to no way of vetting people from these special interest countries."
- Hillary Clinton has outdone her previous "a basket of deplorables" description of millions of Trump supporters. In a recent interview with CNN's Christiane Amanpour, Hillary stated, "And when do they break with him? You know, because at some point, you know, maybe there needs to be a formal deprogramming of the cult members, but something needs to happen."
- 4 While the Biden administration was delaying the evacuation of Americans from Israel after the tragic terrorist attacks, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis signed an executive order and chartered an airplane to rescue trapped Americans. He brought 271 U.S. citizens home to Florida; many of them were children. At the same time, Florida Congressman Cory Mills (a decorated Army combat veteran) and his staff chartered flights and rescued 96 Americans.
- More than 1,600 scientists have signed the World Climate Declaration titled "There Is No Climate Emergency" which stated that carbon dioxide is "essential" to all life on earth. The Global Climate Intelligence Group (CLINTEL) made the declaration public in August, with signatures from highly respected scientists from around the world.
