Named for the river Kamp that runs through it, its leading municipality is Langenlois, Austria's largest wine town – and with 3,582 hectares under vines and numerous internationally known top estates, the Kamptal is one of the most successful wine-growing regions in the country. Culture and tourism also enjoy particular prominence here in the region. Since 2008, the name Kamptal DAC stands for Grüner Veltliner or Riesling, either in the classic-to-middleweight styles, or as a robust dry Reserve-category wine.
