Individual-Not Self-Employed

If you and your spouse do not earn self-employment income, then your tax return and taxes owing are both due May 1, 2023.

Normally, taxes would be due on April 30th, but because that date falls on a Sunday, they can be paid on Monday May 1st without penalty.

This is the most common scenario for taxpayers.

Self-Employed

If you or your spouse earned business income in 2022 then your tax return is due **June 15, 2023.**

This deadline is a bit tricky because taxes owing are still due **May 1, 2023** even though the actual filing of the return is not due until June.

Normally, taxes would be due on April 30th, but because that date falls on a Sunday, they can be paid on Monday May 1st without penalty.
