

• Videos (Halter & Performance)

- Videos must not be edited in any way and must be a continuous shot. Editing will result in immediate disqualification
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the exhibitor, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Each video should only include one "entry" for a single class.
- Video must be in landscape mode
- Be sure to keep the entire horse in the frame at all times.
- Coaching during class is not allowed
- Natural background sound for the class must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- Videotaping for submission must be taken between "show bill postdate" and "10/22/23"
- The decision of the judge is final.
- All breeds of horses, mules, donkeys, and ponies may compete in non-breed specific classes.
- Riders and horses may cross enter into any division for which they qualify.
- Show attire not required, but must be riding-appropriate
- Equipment must be legal for the class in which you enter
- Riders may cross enter W/T and W/T/C, but Tiny Tot may not cross-enter.
- Office Fee is per horse/rider combo or photo
- The Show Committee is not responsible for errors in printing. Correction of any errors will be posted.

Entry Rules

- Check the classes, with or with feedback, you want to enter
- Calculate your show fees, including office fee of \$15.00. One office fee required per horse/rider combo
- Entries begin <u>10/01/23</u> and close <u>10/15/23 midnight CDT.</u>

Halter/Showmanship Classes

Instructions: PB/HA/Other Breeds Halter


- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field) but large enough to permit exhibitor to trot the horse for about 40 feet
- Two cones (or similar markers) are placed 20 feet apart
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the exhibitor, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- The videographer will be stationed at Cone B
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- The exhibitor will walk the horse from Cone A to Cone B and set up for presentation. The videographer will walk around the horse with a 4-5 second pause at each quarter. Be sure to keep the entire horse in the frame at all times. At the end of the circle, the videographer will zoom in slightly to clearly show the halter from both sides, especially the chin strap or chain.
- After the equipment check, the horse should be walked back to Cone A, then turned (either right or left) and trotted in a straight line about 40 feet, giving the viewer a good profile view of the horse at the trot. (Videographer stays at Cone B for the trot profile)

Instructions: Showmanship

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field).
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the exhibitor, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- The videographer will be stationed at marker for the judge
- Follow the instruction for Pattern A (Jr) or Pattern M (Sr)
 Note: Pattern will be emailed upon receipt of class entry.

Instructions: SHIH

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field).
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the exhibitor, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- The videographer will be stationed at marker for the judge

Performance Classes

Instructions: Huntseat/SHUS/Saddleseat/Western Walk/Trot/Canter

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field).
- Videographer will stand in the center of the arena, just as the judge and steward would.
- The videographer may call the gaits.
- The video must be one continuous shot, no splicing videos together or editing.
- Video in landscape mode.
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the horse/rider combo number, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Follow the order of gaits and maneuvers as listed below.
- Perform each gait for approximately 10-30 seconds (video length apr. 2.5 3.5 min)
 Order of gaits (discipline specific):
 - 1. Jog or Trot (counterclockwise)
 - 2. Walk
 - 3. Lope or Canter
 - Walk
 - 4. Reverse at the Walk Continue walking
 - 5. Lope or Canter
 - 6. Walk
 - 7. Jog or Trot
 - 8. Walk
 - 9. Stop & Back one-horse length.

Instructions: Huntseat/Saddleseat/Western Walk/Trot

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field).
- Videographer will stand in the center of the arena, just as the judge and steward would.
- The videographer may call the gaits.
- The video must be one continuous shot, no splicing videos together.
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the horse/rider combo number, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- Be sure to keep the entire horse in the frame at all times.
- Follow the order of gaits and maneuvers as listed below.
- Perform each gait for approximately 10-20 seconds (video length apr. 1.5 2 min) Order of gaits (discipline specific):
 - 1. Walk (counterclockwise)
 - 2. Jog or Trot
 - 3. Reverse at the Walk
 - Continue walking
 - 4. Jog or Trot
 - 5. Walk
 - 6. Stop

Instructions: LEADLINE

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field).
- Videographer will stand in the center of the arena, just as the judge and steward would.
- The videographer may call the gaits.
- The video must be one continuous shot, no splicing videos together.
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the horse/rider combo number, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- Be sure to keep the entire horse in the frame at all times.
- Follow the order of gaits and maneuvers as listed below.
 - Perform each gait for approximately 15-20 seconds (video length apr. 1 1.5 min) Order of gaits (discipline specific):
 - 1. _Walk (counterclockwise)
 - Continue Walk
 - 2. Reverse at the Walk

- Continue walking
- 3. Walk
- 4. Stop

Instructions: Driving

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, round pen, clearing, pasture or field).
- Videographer will stand in the center of the arena, just as the judge and steward would.
- The videographer may call the gaits.
- The video must be one continuous shot, no splicing videos together.
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the horse/rider combo number, the number and name of the class, and the date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.
- Coaching during presentation not allowed
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- Be sure to keep the entire horse & cart in the frame at all times.
- Follow the order of gaits and maneuvers as listed below.
- Perform each gait for approximately 10-30 seconds (video length apr. 2.5 3.5 min) Order of gaits (discipline specific):
 - 1. Normal Trot (counterclockwise)
 - 2. Strong Trot
 - 3. Normal Trot
 - 4. Walk
 - Walk
 - 5. Reverse at the Walk Continue walking
 - 6. Normal Trot
 - 7. Strong Trot
 - 8. Walk
 - 9. Stop & Back one-horse length.

Instructions: Dressage

- You must use any safe and functional area for your class (an arena, clearing, pasture or field).
- Videographer will stand approximately 16 feet behind the letter "C".
- Minimize the use of zooming. Keep in mind that the judge needs to see the entire arena and letters for accuracy.
- The video must be one continuous shot, no splicing videos together or editing.
- Video in landscape mode.
- The natural background sound for the presentation must be audible. Background music is not allowed.
- Before starting the presentation, a sign must be held up showing the name of the horse, the horse/rider combo number, the number and name of the class, and the

date of filming. Please make sure that all information is clear and easy to read for the viewer.

• Equipment check: After the rider has given the final salute, the rider must ride up to "G" and turn the horse so that the horse is broadside to the camera/judge to enable the judge to see and perform an equipment check. Wait 5 seconds, then turn the horse so the judge can perform an equipment check on the other side. Following the equipment check the rider must dismount and safely drop the bit so the videographer can film a "bit check". The bridle needs to be held out in the open, clear of the horse and rider's bodies, so the judge can clearly see the bit. Your video must be one continuous filming without breaks or edits from the time of entry at "A" until the equipment bit check is complete.
