June is just around the corner reminding us that we must start gearing up for summer and wildland fire season. Cal-Fire officially declared the start of Fire Season on May 19, 2009. The question always comes up, how bad will this fire season be? The answer is simple, California burns every year, just more in some years than others. We have been extremely fortunate here over the past several years. We have not had any large fires and what ones did start we were able to get on real quick and put out. Let's hope we get through without anything major happening.

Remember, hot weather, dry grass and dense brush equals easy ignition and rapid fire growth, especially where the terrain is steep. Historical experience indicates that there are 15 to 20 ignitions in the area each year. Ignitions have arisen from cigarettes, machine use, camping, and other human actives. And because of this, they are most likely to occur close to population and structures.

Now is a good time to start getting your home ready for fire season by clearing the grass around your house and out buildings, the State requirement is 100 feet of clearance. Clean out rain gutters of leaves and pine needles off the roof. There is no need to cut the large trees on your property just the ground and ladder fuels like the grass, leaves, low hanging branches, pine needles and brush. If you need help to determine what should be cut and removed please call the fire station (626-9017) and either I, Floyd or someone from the support group who are performing the home evaluations will drop by and give you some advice. Our April meeting had to be held later then normal in the month due to the lack of a quorum so this will be a combination of information from both the April and May meetings.

We have been advertising over the past several months for a new maintenance assistant after Tammy resigned to move on, we thank her for all the hard work she did while she was with us. We would like to congratulate and welcome Kevin Birks as our new assistant, you may have already seen him working with Johnathan replacing fencing along the north side of Rock Creek Rd or mowing at Dyer lake. There was a great group of applicants who made our choice difficult and we thank all of them for their time.

The common areas are looking great and the water level at Dyer Lake has come up nicely. We will be monitoring the level and plan to add more as the summer comes. At the April meeting we finalized the road work package which was sent to 18 different contractors. Thirteen (13) of them came up to do the walk through of the areas. It was great to see so many, our last road bid only attracted 3 bidders so we are hopping to see some great competitive bids come in. they will be reviewed at the road meeting just prior to our next

The Firefighter/Training Officer will have two primary responsibilities. First, to supplement regular, full-time employee staffing during the critical wildland fire season. Second, to assist the Chief in designing and presenting a comprehensive training program to meet the District's Volunteer Firefighter's specific needs. Normal duty time shall consist of eight (8) hours per day, four (4) days per week. The Chief shall establish the duty schedule.
