DOT has announced that Mosquito Road will be **closed August 14 thru September 15**. The roadway will be closed 24 hours a day throughout the duration of this project. The Maintenance Division will also be performing Mosquito Bridge maintenance for approximately 15 working days of this 25 Working Day Project. 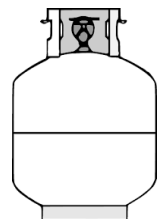
Most of El Dorado County is considered a high hazard fire environment. Based on past experiences, this area possesses all the ingredients necessary to support large, intense, and uncontrolled wildfires. Within this hazardous environment, there are individual homes, subdivisions, and entire communities. Many homes, however, would be unable to survive an intense wildfire.

Since it is not a question of "if" wildfires will occur but "when" they will occur, the likelihood of human life and property loss is great and growing. Our ability to live more safely in this fire environment greatly depends upon our use of pre-fire activities. Pre-fire activities are actions taken before a wildfire occurs which improve the survivability of people and homes. They include proper vegetation management around homes (known as defensible space), use of fire resistant building materials, appropriate subdivision design and other measures. Research clearly shows that pre-fire activities save lives and property.

Fire is a natural part of our environment. Our forests and range lands were burning long before our community existed. Many homes have been built and maintained in this fire environment without regard to wildfire. With more people using our wildlands, there is a greater chance of wildfire starts. Today's wildfires can burn intensely and be difficult to control. Therefore, the potential exists for greater loss of life, increased property losses, more damage to natural resources, and more money needed for firefighting.

### Propane Safety – Tips for Your Home

- To readily recognize a leak, know what propane smells like. Propane retailers have pamphlets available with a scratch-and-sniff spot so that your entire family can recognize the smell.
- If you smell a leak, immediately evacuate everyone and call 911 from a neighbor's home. Do not remain in the building, use the telephone or light switches or try to determine the source of the leak by yourself.
- Be aware of where propane gas service lines are located, especially when working in the yard.
- All furnaces can collect lint and dirt and should be cleaned regularly. Contact your local propane supplier or follow the manufacturer's instruction for information on proper cleaning.



- Have your range serviced if the burner flame is not blue. The blue flame indicates complete combustion. A yellow flame means air inlets are clogged or burners need adjustment. Contact your propane supplier's service department immediately.

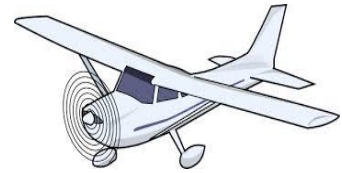

### **EL DORADO COUNTY TO PERFORM ROAD WORK WITH FULL ROAD CLOSURES & DETOURS IN THE MOSQUITO – SWANSBORO COMMUNITY August 14, 2017 through September 22, 2017**

July 24, 2017

El Dorado County's Department of Transportation will be performing road work with full road closures and detours on Mosquito Road from the gate at the south side of the South Fork American River to the north side of the Mosquito Bridge beginning on Monday, August 14, 2017. Repairs are scheduled to continue through September 22, 2017 with road closure for the duration of the project.

Access for local residents, visitors, emergency personnel and law enforcement will be available on Rock Creek Road as an alternate route during the work period. Detour notifications will be posted approximately one week in advance of the closure, and will be clearly posted and in effect for the duration of the closure. These closures are necessary to ensure motorist and worker safety while the County's contractor performs work on the roadway.

The repairs consist of drainage, roadway, and retaining wall improvements to repair a failed culvert and section of the roadway just south of the Mosquito Bridge that was damaged during the storms in January and February earlier this year. The County will also be performing annual maintenance on the Mosquito Bridge during this closure.

Portable changeable message signs will be placed at the approaches to each end of the work zone to keep motorists updated on the schedule for full road closures. The County sincerely appreciates the cooperation and patience of motorists that use these roadway facilities and we apologize for any inconvenience as a result of this closure.

## Thai Cucumber Salad

"This sweet and tangy summer salad of cucumber, cilantro, and peanuts with just a hint of heat is always a hit at picnics and potlucks since it doesn't need to be refrigerated and you're pretty much guaranteed to be the only one bringing this dish!"

### Ingredients

3 large cucumbers, peeled, halved lengthwise, seeded, and cut into 1/4-inch slices  
1 tablespoon salt  
1/2 cup white sugar  
1/2 cup rice wine vinegar  
2 jalapeno peppers, seeded and chopped  
1/4 cup chopped cilantro  
1/2 cup chopped peanuts

### Directions


1. Toss the cucumbers with the salt in a colander, and leave in the sink to drain for 30 minutes. Rinse with cold water, then drain and pat dry with paper towels.
2. Whisk together the sugar and vinegar in a mixing bowl until the sugar has dissolved. Add the cucumbers, jalapeno peppers, and cilantro; toss to combine. Sprinkle chopped peanuts on top before serving.
