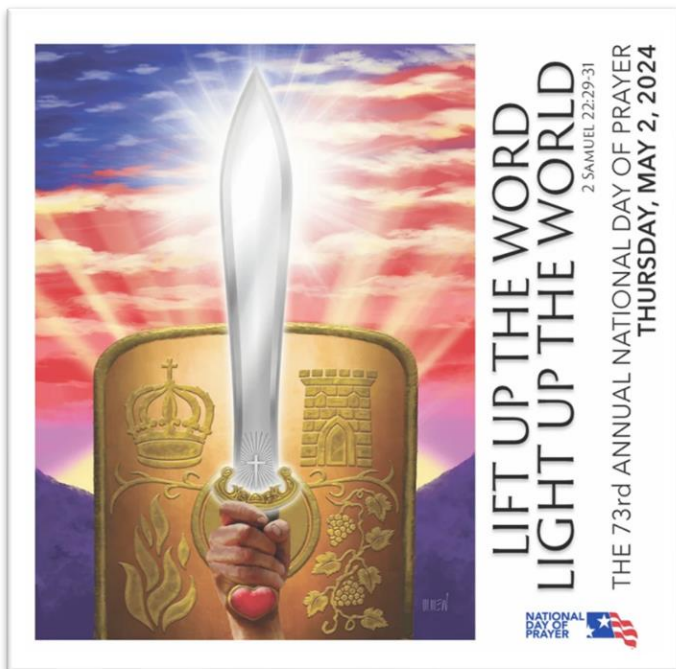
CHOOSE LIFE
