# SAFE WORSHIP GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICES

#### YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SYMPTOMATIC:

- HAVE BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 IN THE PAST 14 DAYS.
- HAVE A FEVER (NORMAL TEMPERATURE SHOULD NOT EXCEED 100° FAHRENHEIT)
   OR IF YOU HAVE HAD A FEVER WITHIN 48 HOURS.
- IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING A COUGH, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, SORE THROAT, LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL, VOMITING OR DIARRHEA IN THE LAST 24 HOURS.
- HAND SANITIZER WILL BE AVAILABLE AT OR NEAR ALL POINTS OF ENTRY TO THE BUILDING.

- WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS (COVERING NOSE AND MOUTH) BY ALL PERSONS IN THE HOUSE OF WORSHIP. FACE COVERINGS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT ENTRANCES TO INDIVIDUALS IF REQUESTED.
