## **Artist Submission Requirements:**

We are always looking for great talent and would be happy to meet with you.

Our submission procedure for entry into Eye Candy Gallery is as follows:

- 1) All artists will submit via email a minimum of 5 high quality photographs of their work as well as a short statement/biography concerning themselves & their art/inspiration/ training, etc. If you have a website, please add that information to your email. The gallery will acknowledge receipt of the email and within a few days, we will contact the artist to advise as to whether or not the artwork is of interest to the gallery.
- 2) Once favorable notification is received, we require all artists to schedule an appointment to meet with the gallery director and/or owner. "Drop-ins" will be turned away.
- 3) At the appointment, we would like the artist to bring a good sample representation of his or her work. Four to six pieces is usually appropriate. All pieces selected for showing in our galleries must be framed to gallery standards. This means that all frames should be made of wood; no plexiglass or acrylic sheeting, preferably no glare free glass; mounted and matted using only 100% archival materials.
- 4) If accepted to the gallery, the artist should then provide a more extended artist's statement as well as a high quality "head shot" within 10 days so that we may represent you on our website.

We do require all artists to complete a consignment agreement with the gallery. This will be provided during the appointment or may be requested in advance. The salient high points of the agreement are that your works will be accepted for consignment only, that all works held at the gallery are insured, that you retain all copyrights to your work and that the commission fee for the sale of your work is 50%.
