

CHILD SAFE VISITS CODE OF CONDUCT CUSTODIAL PARENT

PLEASE READ AND INITIAL EACH ITEM

	Copies of all court orders will be provided to the monitor and must be followed; the monitor's Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.	
	I agree to arrive on time at the agreed site and leave immediately after the exchange is made. *A late fee will be charged if time exceeds 15 minutes.	
	I agree to be responsible for the transportation of child(ren) to and from the visit site unless alternate arrangements have been made with the monitor or stipulated by the court.	
	Following or harassing non-custodial parent, after the visit, is prohibited.	
	No weapons are allowed during exchanges.	
	l agree not to contact the child(ren) or non-custodial parent during visits. (Including phone calls, text messages, etc.) *Excludes emergencies	
	Negative conversations about the non-custodial parent or pending court case, in front of child(ren), is prohibited.	
	No written or verbal messages will be relayed to non-custodial parent by the child(ren).	
	No written or verbal messages will be relayed to non-custodial parent by the monitor, unless it is pertaining to the visitation.	
	Visitation Monitors are mandated by the court to report ANY circumstance that compromises the child(ren)'s health, safety or welfare. Including but not limited to sexual misconduct, abuse, or the threat of violence against the child or non-custodial parent.	
	Cancellation of a visit without proper notice will be subject to a cancellation fee. In the event of illness, a doctor's note will need to be provided to the monitor.	
	I understand that in the event the Primary Monitor is unavailable, I agree to a qualified Substitute Monitor in his/her place.
