RULES AND REGULATIONS UNDER WHICH ENTRIES WILL BE COSIDERED

Fmail:

- 1. Parade units may have individuals walk alongside a parade unit and distribute candy, flags, coupons, or merchandise to spectators along the parade route as long as they are adjacent to the spectators and do not have to throw the items.
- 2. Because of the time limit of the parade <u>all entries must not stop</u> during the parade route. Walking maneuvers, yells, etc. are allowed only if they do not slow the parade pace.
- 3. Parade units must stay in their assigned area and not disturb other units by walking in and through other units during the parade.
- 4. Marching units will consist of bands, military, high school, university or college, or adult civic marching groups.
- 5. The Black Heritage Society and the City of Houston assume no responsibility for accidents by any participant. If entering a vehicle, specialty or antique car or truck, proof of current liability insurance coverage for the specific parade vehicle is required upon application approval.
- 6. The Black HS and the City of Houston to create and actively promote a welcoming and inclusive parade environment for the City of Houston, its residents, and visitors. Neither the strutters organization nor discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender (including identity), age sexual orientation, health status, or disability.
