Data

The Data Workgroup recently received the youth survey data. The report was reviewed and key takeaways were included in our presentation material. We have presented the data to two school Administration groups already and provided them with their school specific information. Additional presentations will be scheduled. Group conversations are also being scheduled with students to ask more detailed questions that could not be included in the survey. This information has been used to validate information received and identify regional issues or perceptions from the youth.

Alcohol & Tobacco Products/ Policy

The group has been working with Lamar advertising on billboard designs to be displayed this spring. The messages will focus on the dangers of underage drinking and supplying to minors. We also continue to work on updating school tobacco policies in all districts in both counties. Synar education (age and tobacco law) for all businesses who sell tobacco products took place in March.



Funding

The CTC Funding Workgroup just wrapped up our partner raffle with Timberline Resort in Crivitz. Timberline conducted a pull-tag raffle for a rifle and donated all of the proceeds to our group. A second one just started and with a busy camping season coming right around the corner (hopefully winter will end), we look forward to a second raffle concluding. Each raffle earns approximately \$500 for the Funding Workgroup while at the same time spreading awareness of CTC throughout the Crivitz and Wausaukee areas.



Outreach and Maintenance

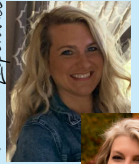

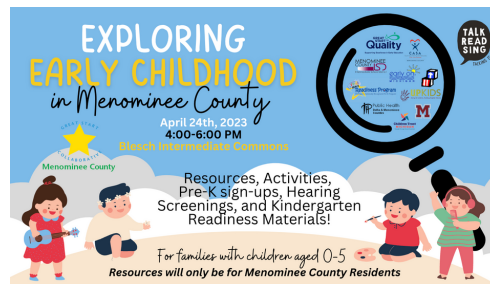
