Data

The Data Committee's main focus has been the preparation of the youth survey that is completed every other year. Standard questions are reviewed, and specific questions are added associated to local community concerns. The surveys will be handled electronically and will be occurring in October. This data will be used to identify trends, provide feedback to local stakeholders, and identify potential CTC initiatives. In addition to the survey preparation, community presentations continue to happen for awareness and community support. The most recent presentations were to the Marinette Lion's Club and Menominee Kiwanis.



Funding

The CTC Funding workgroup had a busy summer. We held our first annual brat fry at the Timberline Resort in Crivitz. We partnered up with the JW Ranch to provide a fun afternoon for kids in our area. There are continued talks of new future fundraising opportunities with the owner of the Timberline.

We are well underway planning for our third annual Kids Ice fishing derby at Red Arrow Park. This year is starting off strong. We secured a grant from our local Walmart and have purchased our own tent for the event. This will save us from having to rent one. We also have secured some strong funding from past local donors already, and our contact at Silver Moon Springs trout hatchery has us penciled in for stocking February 11th.



Outreach and Maintenance

The Outreach Workgroup heard from Alissa Hanlon with Local IQ- USA Today Marketing Network at their August meeting. She discussed the numerous ways she could assist CTC with reaching people in the community and expand beyond our current network. Workgroup members are tasked with posting on social media platforms. Alcohol & Tobacco Policy

Our workgroup participated in Alcohol Action Network's (AAN) Alcohol Compliance Assessment Process (A-CAP) to take a closer look at the softening of alcohol policy that started during the shutdown, focusing on home delivery, curbside pick up and cocktails/alcohol to go. AAN is collecting information to understand how these new alcohol purchasing policies are working and if more support is needed for monitoring and enforcement. We also assisted Delta Menominee Health Department with their tobacco SYNAR education and compliance checks. The virtual Underage Drinking Town Hall education series took place at the end of the 2021-22 school year in Wausaukee, Goodman and North Central school districts.
